A By-law for allowing a rate of discount on the Assessments on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown for general civic purposes for the current year ending the thirty-first day of December, A. D. 1905.

THE MASSACRED NUMBERED 7,000

The Fiendish Odessa Plot is Said to Have Been Engineered by Police to Crush Insurrection.

LONDON, July 5.—The Odessa correspondent of the Standard says:—Hitherto it has been a very partially penetrable veil which has hidden the ghastly tragedy of the nights of June 27 and 28. At last, it has been lifted and the mind recoils from the truth. My authorities are unimpeachable. For many months past about 150 specially chosen agents have appeared from the third section of police, under the variety of disguises, chiefly of artisans. These agents labored in intimate association with the working people in the industrial suburbs of Perassy and Modayanka, and frequented all the search-haunts of the Social Democratic revolutionists. These agents provocateur know every secret and every movement of the revolutionary propaganda. Their infamous roll was played with consummate horri-fic success. The arrival of the mutinous battalions Kiziaz Potemkin was expected and the ground for the statement would let the naval rebels "and protect the revolutionists ashore. It should be noted that none of the local police, but third section secret agents, were the organizers and engineers of the whole fiendish plot. As already stated, the pillage, wreckage and arson commenced early in the evening, but there was ab-

TORONTO'S NEW WATER SUPPLY

M. J. Haney Has Been Awarded the Contract For the Construction of Tunnel to Cost \$287,000.

TORONTO, July 6.—M. J. Haney, has signed the contract for the construction of a Tunnel under the Bay for Toronto's new water supply. The contract price is \$287,000.

The instructions to the recently appointed Power Commission are much wider than was at first supposed, and seem to indicate stringent Government control over the rates for the supply of hydraulic or electrical energy generated from the provincial water powers. The Commissioners are to ascertain the rates of prices that would require to be charged the consumers of hydraulic or electrical power in order to meet all the expenditure of maintenance and operation; and to ascertain the saving that would accrue annually to the consumers by the substitution of such rates, for the rates now paid. The commission will also ascertain the actual cost of the existing hydraulic and electrical power undertakings, the capacity, state of development, quantity of power supplied and contracted for the rates charged, actual value of such undertakings, and the estimated capital, if any, necessary to complete them.
