OYSTER shipments yesterday, via Point du Chene—123 bbls.

Mrs. Thomas Henderson and children, who have been visiting in Boston, returned home last evening.

Mr. R. C. McLeod shipped 1450 geese to Mansfield, Mass., yesterday morning. They are fed on a farm there until they become marketable.

J. H. Myrick & Co, of Tignish, shipped yesterday to Chicago 276 cases lobsters and 125 cases blue berries, the total value of which was \$1,813.

Mr. Palmer who has had charge of the tunnel borings, was in Summerside yesterday. Senator Howland and the Hon. Angus McMillan were also here.

The Women's Christian Temperance Union will meet in the Y. M. C. A. rooms to-morrow (Thursday) afternoon at 3 o'clock sharp. A full attendance is requested.

The men who are rebuilding the east gable of the Post Office building found the wall in a very shaky condition, and had it not been torn down it must soon have fallen.

Miss Mary Doull, of Charlottetown, gives her first painting lesson in Summerside to day at the residence of the residence of Dr. McIntyre. We understand that she starts with about a dozen pupils.

The young ladies' branch of the Women's Foreign Mission Society, in connection with the Presbyterian church here, intends holding a tea and bazaar on the 20th of this month in the new school room.

The Miramichi sailed for Montreal yesterday about noon with the largest freight she has taken away this summer. She had 995 bbls oysters for Quebec and Montreal, 80 bush potatoes and some small freight.

SEVENTY-one passengers crossed to Point du Chene yesterday morning. Forty-five returned to Summerside in the evening, among whom were a number of Presbyterian ministers and elders returning from the meeting of the Synod at St. John, N. B.

YESTERDAY morning fifteen horses were shipped per Northumberland, the lot being valued at \$1625. Eleven of these went to St. John, and were shipped by Mr. R. Sted; three went to Chatham, two by Mr. John Clark, and one by Mr. P. R. Baker, and one went to Point Elgin. As a whole they were rather a fine looking lot of horses.

The first move in Kindergarten work in Summerside will be made on Monday next when Miss Willis of Pictou, N. S., will open a school in the room over Mr. Daniel Stewart's Clothing Store. Miss Willis received her training at the Dartmouth (N. S.) Kindergarten, and comes to Summerside highly recommended. This Kindergarten is a step in the right direction, and we hope that it will receive sufficient support to make it a success.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council took place Monday evening. Councillor Compton occupied the chair in the absence of Chairman Hunt, who was indisposed, and there were present beside: Councillors Fanning, Dickson, Campbell and Macleod. The usual number of bills, etc., were ordered paid. A petition was received from Misses Macphail and Schurman, late teachers in the Eastern District School, asking for "a statement showing that we are citizens of Summerside and have taught school therein," as they are about to leave the Island and wished to carry it with them. "Three months ago," they say, "we applied to the School officials for this simple act of justice, but they have seen fit to ignore our request." The Council discussed the matter, and seemed to be of the opinion that the School board should have granted the certificate asked for. A committee, consisting of Compton and Campbell, was appointed to confer with the Chairman of the School board, with power to draw up the document in case the board declined. The Council ordered that five dollars be paid to close the account of widening and improving Summerside street near the School. The Council adjourned early.

PERSONS using the Telephone would find talking much more satisfactory if they would observe the following Rules:

2nd. Speak in a moderate tone of voice, not too loud, and distinctly.

3rd. Place the Telephone so as to cover the Ear, just as if you wished to shut out all other sounds. Do not press too hard on the Ear.

It is possible to talk and be heard when standing back two or three feet from the transmitter, if you shout loud enough, but it is not a pleasant mode of conversation, is entirely unnecessary, and is a useless waste of wind and lungs, besides being very annoying to all within range of your voice.
