## SAY WORLD IS NEAR END

### Adventists Find Chinese War Predicted in Revelations and Protending Judgment Day.

Does the present war in China signify the beginning of the end of the world?

Prophets are springing up all over the country to declare that it does. They base their claims on the scriptures. In Philadelphia Adventist Fathers are announcing that the outbreak in the far East is the blowing of the seventh trumpet mentioned in the book of Revelation, at the sound of which the great dragon rose up out of the sea and all the nations of the world fought together. Out on the Pacific coast a prophet named Jones has arisen, who devotes an entire book to proving how in the Bible are accurately prophesied all the important events in human history which have occurred since the Book of Books was written, and how in the same way and with the same certainty the awakening of the Yellow Terror of Asia marks the final war among all the nations of the earth, in the midst of which "time shall cease to be and the struggling hosts shall be stricken dumb in a moment."

Prophet Jones is systematic. In the second and in the seventh chapters of the book of Daniel he finds prefigured the story the nations of western Europe; in the thirty-eight and thirty-ninth chapters of Ezekiel telling of Russia's place in the world. In Daniel XII and XIII the so-called Eastern question is described, and then Mr. Jones passes on to events which are still in the future, but which he declares are on the eve of fulfillment. He lays particular emphasis on the following verses from the book of Revelation:

And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great River Euphrates and the water thereof was dried up that the way of the Kings of the East might be prepared.—Revelation xii., 13.

And he saith unto me the waters which thou sawest are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.—Revelation xvii. 15.

#### SULTAN FIGURES IN IT.

The River Euphrates flows down from the mountains of Armenia into the Persian Gulf. Its valley is owned by the unspeakable Turk. When the power of the Sultan shall be crushed, which is what is meant by the "drying up of the waters" of the River Euphrates, then the sixth trumpet will have sounded and the way will be clear for the coming of the "Kings of the East" to the great battlefields, which shall immediately precede the last days of the world.

The modern statesmen look upon the existence of Turkey as the great barrier which keeps the powers of Europe from flying at each other's throat.

#### AMERICA A KING OF THE EAST.

He mentions the fact that the United States recently had serious trouble with the Sultan and that there are other symptoms that the "Sick man of Europe" is on his deathbed and that soon the waters of the Euphrates will be dried up, indeed. By acquiring the Philippine Islands Prophet Jones declares that the United States became one of the Eastern powers and must therefore be enrolled with the Kings of the East, which are marching on together to the last and greatest of the battlefields of all history. Having cleared up these preliminaries, the prophet continues his quotations from Revelation:

And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles which go forth unto the Kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

#### MEANS CHINESE DRAGON.

Here he points out the Chinese dragon is plainly mentioned, and that the present situation in China, where all the powers are fighting side by side, is clearly pre-figured. As for the "false prophet" of the quotation, that surely refers again to Turkey and to the Mohammedan power all over the world. And prophet Jones, who is a student and a great traveler, finds grounds for predicting that out of the present war in China will grow complications between the powers that will result in driving the Sultan from Constantinople and in finally arraying all the Christian nations of the world in solid phalanx against the forces of the "dragon and the beast" and the "false prophet," the last battle ground being Asia.

Here are some more verses which Prophet Jones and the other prophet declare refer to the present condition of things.

And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns and seven crowns upon his heads.—Revelation xii., 17

Thus in China, the symbol of which is the dragon, the Emperor and his six Ministers of state together make seven heads of the government, while the adminis-

stration of the empire is in the hands of seven separate boards of government.

And the dragon went to make war with the remnant of her seed which keep the commandments of God.—Revelation xii. 17

#### WAR WITH THE DRAGON.

Here is typified the fury with which the Chinese are attacking and killing, the Christian missionaries and waging a war of extermination against all the "white devils" representing the Christian nations of the earth.

All the nations of the world, say these modern prophets, have been preparing for the last fifty years for the final great conflict. The world is now concentrating her forces for this final battle which will follow closely upon the heels of the present war in China.

"And what then?" asks Prophet Jones. "And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great Prince which standeth for the children of thy people; and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time, and that is exactly what all the great powers expect." concludes the prophet.
