Aladdin answered that he was.

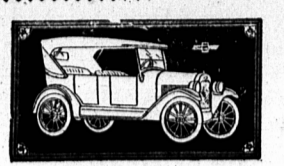
"I knew it," cried the stranger, throwing his arms about the lad.

**FORCE AND SPLASH FEED LUBRICATION SYSTEM**

Many modern cars have adopted this system because of its certainty to supply oil to all parts of the engine.

Its operation is almost the same as the force feed but in addition, has a pipe line leading to wells below the connecting rods into which dippers installed on the rod dip and throw the oil around the rod bearings. The main bearings and lining gears are usually lubricated directly from the pump through the pipe line. There is one advantage to this system, over the force feed, in case of trouble with the pump whilst on a trip an extra quart or two of oil in the base will enable the car to proceed without much chance of trouble. This is not so with a force feed system, where the car cannot proceed under its own power if the oil pump does not work. The gauge in the force and splash system is the indicator of safety and the strainer the part to clean out monthly.
