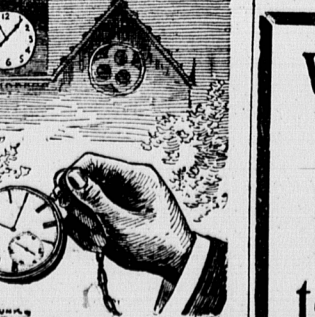

HOW SHRUBB STARTED TO RACE FIRST

LONDON, March 2.—Alfie Shrubbs in telling of his career as a runner, says his first three mile run was to a big file when he was about 18 years old. Shortly after that, he said, he joined an athletic club and for a number of years competed as an amateur in races from one to ten miles, ran not only in England, but in France, Germany, and other European countries as well. He said his fastest time was in Glasgow in 1903, when he ran ten miles in 50 minutes 40 seconds. The Glasgow track Shrubbs declared to have been the best over which he ever ran.

Shrubbs went to Australia, in 1904, and competed with the best athletes in the various cities, as well as in New Zealand. When leaving Melbourne, Australia, for New Zealand, he said, the steamer on which he was a passenger took fire, and he had to put back. He lost several days by that, and arrived in New Zealand one day before he had to race, thus giving him no time for preparation. He won the contest, however.

Shortly after returning to England, Shrubbs said he was suspended from amateur tracks because he had accepted a ticket from a friend in Canada to go to that country. He then declared to become a professional runner. Shrubbs declared he had no fault to find with his suspension, and added that in order to keep athletics clean, rules must be lived up to.

SENATE REFORM OF NO INTEREST TO SENATORS.

OTTAWA, March 5.—In the Senate, Hon. Mr. Scott launched his scheme of Senate reform by moving a resolution endorsing the principle of making the Upper House two-thirds elective by popular vote and one-third appointive by Crown, with eight year tenure of office in each case. The venerable Ex-Secretary of State made out a strong case for the need of reform along the lines suggested. He spoke of only a small and somewhat uninterested attendance of Senators, the majority of whom did not show any desire to reform themselves out of office.

CANADIAN CURLERS HAVE ARRIVED HOME.

HALIFAX, March 5.—Amid the skirling of pipes and hearty cheering from hundreds, the victorious Canadian Curling team arrived in Halifax bearing the Strathcona Cup which they wrested from the best curlers in Scotland. Twenty-three of the original 37 reached Canada on the Empress of Ireland. Fourteen, who went to the International Bosphorus in Switzerland and there in the championship of the world will follow on a later boat.

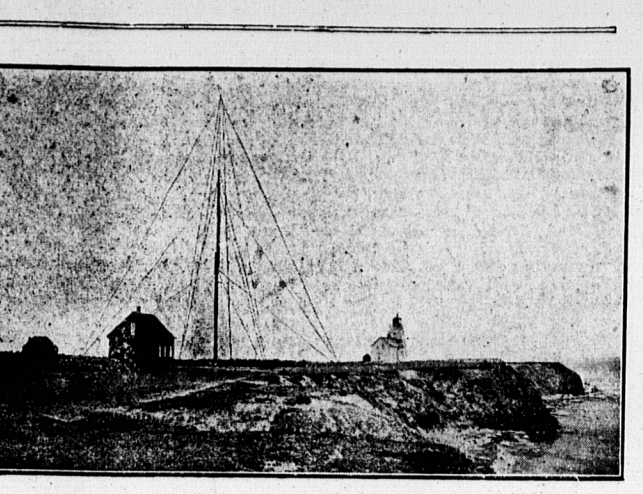

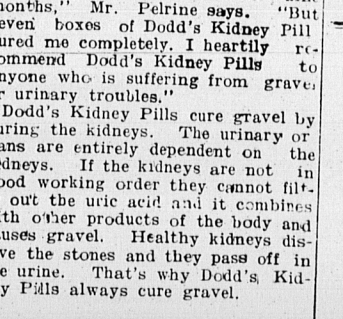

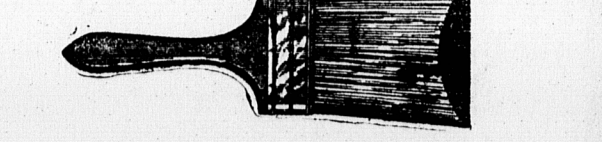
