

SUMMERSIDE PREPARING FOR GRAND HOME-COMING

Partial Program for the Summer Carnival During the Reunion of Islanders—Two Weeks of Entertainment in the Western Capital

The program for the grand Reunion of Islanders and Summer Carnival to be held in Summerside between the 11th and 23rd of July next is nearing completion. It is difficult at this date to give the details; but an outline of the events will be of interest to the many who are anxious to know what is being done. The following is as near as can at present be disclosed:—

FIRST WEEK

Monday July 11—Formal opening and Reception in evening to all returned Islanders and visiting strangers. Fireworks etc.

Tuesday July 12—Orange Celebration. Wednesday—July 13—Yacht Races in Summerside Harbor for P. E. Island

Championship cup and other prizes; other aquatic sports.

Thursday July 14—Rifle Matches, Quoit Matches etc. being arranged for.

Friday July 15—Annual Faturity Stake Horse Races on Summerside Driving Park, conducted by the Gentlemen's Driving Club—Four classes, upwards of 25 entries.

Saturday July 16—Merchants' Day, Mercantile display, to be arranged for.

SECOND WEEK

Monday July 18—England's Day—Celebrated by the Sons of England Benevolent Societies under the direction of Hanover Lodge, Summerside, program being arranged.

Tuesday July 19—Ireland's Day—Celebrated by the Irish Societies of Prince County, under the direction of Rev. A. E. Burke of Alberton, program not yet completed.

Wednesday July 20—Scotland's Day—Celebrated by the Caledonia Club of P. E. I.—Annual Scottish Gathering on the Summerside Driving Park.

Thursday July 21—United States Day—Celebrated by the Y. M. C. A. of Summerside, program not yet arranged.

Friday July 22—Canada's Day—Celebrated by The Summerside Improvement and Tourist Association, program for day being arranged, Moonlight Excursion on S. S. Northumberland at night. Saturday July 23—Merchants' Day.

The special services in the Baptist church, conducted by Rev. J. Harry King, are well attended and full of interest. There will be service Friday evening of this week and on Sunday evening next.

The high price being paid for potatoes has induced farmers to dispose of them readily. During the past two days about 10,000 bushels were purchased by the merchants of Summerside. The price remains at 40c with good demand.

JOSEPH READ & Co have loaded the scho. Malabar with potatoes and are now loading the Soh Telephone also with potatoes. Yesterday on the ice about the schooner the large number of teams unloading potatoes presented quite a lively appearance.

The regular monthly meeting of the Summerside School Board was held Tuesday evening. There was little business of importance. The Supervisor's report showed a total enrolment of 382, average daily attendance 321, percentage of attendance 89, visits made by teacher and parents 61.

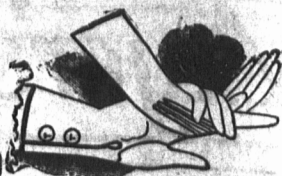
