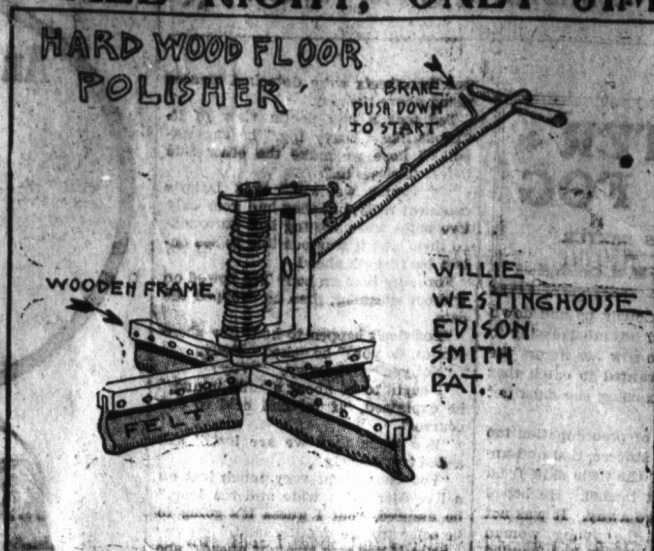


WILLIE'S POLISHER WORKED ALL RIGHT, ONLY JIM LET GO OF THE HANDLE



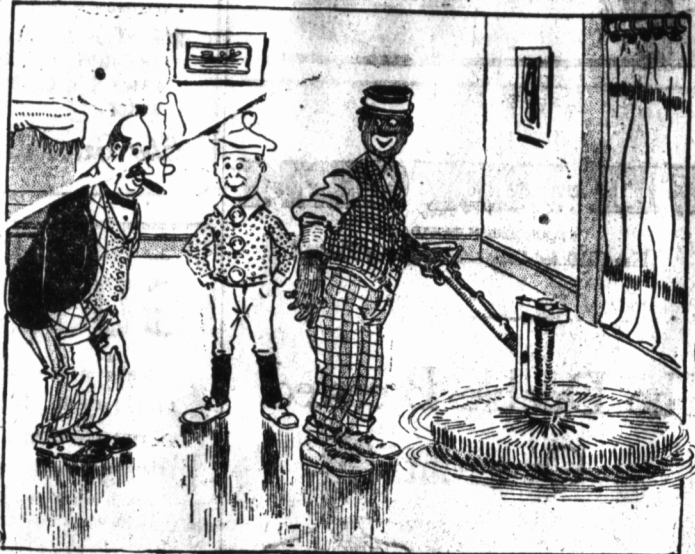
Dear Tommy—Jim has to come up to the house every week and polish the floors. It takes him a whole day—



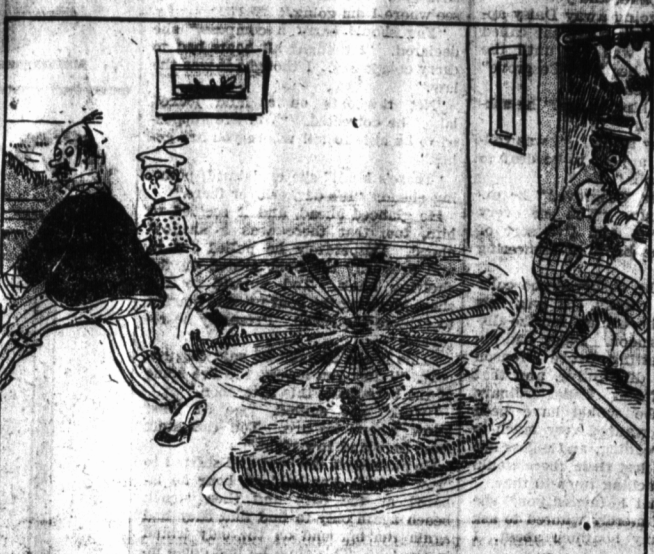
And is such hard work that I made Jim a polisher like this diagram—
