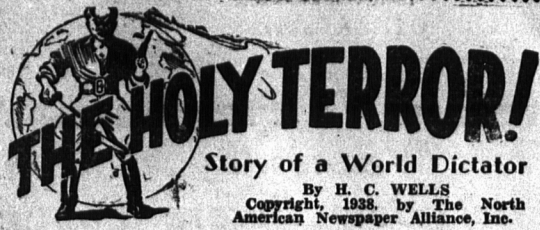

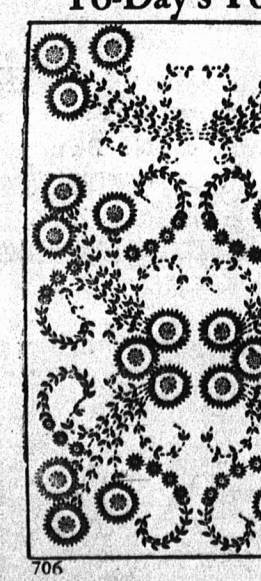
Q. Should a man always rise for an introduction? A. Yes, regardless of whether he is being introduced to a woman or a man, and regardless of age.

A SUFPLE NECK ADDS TO YOUR APPEARANCE The neck and throat need quite a lot of attention these days of swept-up hair fashions. The neck should be kept supple and a few simple exercises will help.

PAJAMAS "Cotton trousers are worn in bed by men and women," reported a Frenchman, held captive in the Orient, to a shocked Europe in 1610. Though the revelation by Francis Pyrrard of the amazing habits of the Goa populace is the earliest known mention of pajamas by a European, according to illustrations the Eastern women wore trousered legs even in 3,000 B.C.

The word itself suggests its Oriental origin, for it can be broken down into the Persian words, "pa (d)" meaning leg, and "jama", meaning garment. In the 18th Century a famous Goya painting showed a Spanish lady with legs dressed in gauze garments but it wasn't until 1882 that London merchants advertised pajamas as a new fashion.

Less than 20 years ago the ancient fashion became the height of modernity and pajamas were stepped gaily from the boudoir to the drawing room, beach and ballroom, and became for many women the favored garments for work, lounging and even dancing while in some circles they acquired the title of "smoke suits."

APPLE CRUMB PUDDING 3-4 cup brown sugar 2-4 cup flour 1-2 cup butter 3 cups cooked apples or uncooked. Place pieces of apple or apple sauce in bottom of baking dish.
