FAITH IN CANADA

England Not Worrying About Food Supplies—Looks to Dominion

Great Britain has unbounded faith in Canada, its ability and readiness to supply foodstuffs for the army and people of the Motherland, even if all other sources of supply should be cut off as the result of the War, according to a statement made by Mr. W. R. Brock, a big Toronto wholesaler, on his return from Europe. He said Canada's gift of 1,000,000 bags of flour made a great impression in England. It stiffened the backs of the working classes as nothing else could have done, for it had made them realize there was a huge granary within the Empire that could not be touched by any foreign foe. The full force of the impression made by the gift was aptly epitomized by a manufacturer, who said to Mr. Brock: "We need not worry, Canada will feed us."
