DROPS DEAD ON ROOF.

NEW YORK, Nov. 26—Stricken with apoplexy while at work on top of a three-story building on Bergen avenue, New York, Samuel E. Carman, carpenter and builder, a member of one of the oldest and best known families in Jamaica, fell today. Near by on the roof with him was Frank Sprague, a mechanic, who was assisting him. Sprague leaped forward and caught the body in time to save it from falling to the ground. Sprague had noticed a change coming over Carman's face and was approaching him at the time the man was stricken. Crumpling into an unconscious heap, the body started to slide down the sharp grade of the slanting roof. Holding the body with one hand and hanging on with the other, the workman shouted for help. Dr. Van Sieten came to his assistance and together they tied a rope around the body and lowered it to the courtyard. The physician pronounced him dead.

FATALLY CRUSHED AT GLACE BAY.

GLACE BAY, Nov. 26—Giuseppe Bacome, a young Italian, was killed in No. 1 colliery yesterday afternoon. The unfortunate man was employed on a level where trips of boxes are run. It appears that he had been reading and failed to get his door open in time for the trip to pass through. As he was about to open the door the heavily loaded boxes caught him and crushed his chest in against the door. When he removed from his position it was found that life had departed.

The ship came down recently from Hudson Bay, where she had had on board an expedition in connection with the hydrographic service.
