CORN CUSTARD.

Score the kernel in a dozen ears of green corn, scrape out the pulp and add to the beaten yolks of four eggs a teaspoon of salt and a saltspoon of pepper. Add one pint of milk and mix, then stir carefully the stiffly beaten whites of four eggs, pour into a buttered pudding dish and bake slowly until firm.

ROXBURY CREAM PIE.

One and one half cups sugar, one and one half cups of flour, five eggs a little lemon. Beat the yolks and sugar well, then add the whites, previously beaten to a stiff froth, with which has been sifted a level teaspoonful of baking powder. Fill with the following: To two-thirds of a pint of boiling milk; add one cup of flour. Beat with two eggs. Let it boil two or three minutes, flavour to suit and set in a cool place.

BURNT SUGAR CAKE.

Beat one half cup of butter to cream; add gradually one and one half cups sugar, one cup of water, yolks of two eggs, two cups of flour then add two teaspoons of burnt sugar, then one cup of flour in which two teaspoons of baking powder has been added; lastly the beaten whites of the eggs. Flavour with vanilla. To make burnt sugar put one half cup of sugar in a pan and let it brown until it smokes, then add one half cup of boiling water, let cook till syrup, icing for this cake two cups of sugar, one half cup of water, three teaspoons of burnt sugar; cook until it threads; pour over the beaten whites.

GOODIES FOR THE CHRISTMAS SEASON

At no time of the year are fancy cakes, cookies, and candies so welcome as at the Christmas season. In my own family we have always devoted an entire day, shortly before Christmas, just to candy making. All help, and when the work is done, we have an ample supply to last until school opens again, and plenty to copias for friendly gifts, cornucopia for the Christmas table and thing very difficult or very elaborate where the children can help, it heightens the work and adds to their pleasure. Here are some of our favorite recipes used at this time.

FRENCH FONDANT

Stir into the white of an egg an equal quantity of water; then work into the mixture all the sifted confectioner's or XXX sugar it will take. Separate into as many bowls as you want flavors; put a teaspoonful of vanilla extract with one cupful, two another (adding sugar enough to stiffen again), rose-water in a third, orange, lemon, and almond flavoring in other bowls.

NUT CREAMS

Roll small balls of the fondant and press halves of walnut or pecan seeds on opposite sides. Set on waxed paper to harden.

CHOCOLATE CREAMS

Dip tiny cones of the fondant into chocolate, which has been melted in the double boiler. Lift out carefully with two forks, and set on buttered plates or waxed paper. Bitter chocolate may be used, or the special sweet chocolate that comes for the purpose. Keep the melted chocolate at an even temperature, about ninety-six degrees, and keep stirring it thoroughly. Dry the chocolate in cool place. If you allow them to become cold and then warm again, they are apt to look streaky.

STUFFED DATES

Remove pits from the dates through a lengthwise slit. Roll a long narrow piece of vanilla fondant, lay in the place of the stone, and set the date aside. Peanuts, almonds, or any nuts, also candied pineapple and marsh-mallows make good fillings for dates; roll the fruit in granulated sugar to neutralize the stickiness of the outside. Keep stuffed dates in tins, or they will become hard.

PLAIN FUDGE

Melt two squares of unsweetened chocolate over hot water. Add two cupfuls of light-brown or A sugar, a cupful of milk, and a trace of salt. Cook for twelve minutes after boiling begins, but do not allow the boiling to be too violent or the sugar

ar will crystallize against the sides of the pan and precipitate granulation of the whole. Take from the fire and stand in a pan of cold water, and beat steadily till thick. Add one teaspoonful of vanilla and turn out on a buttered platter. Mark before it is too stiff. For maple fudge use maple sugar.

PINUCHI

Four cupfuls of light-brown sugar, two rounded tablespoonfuls of butter, and one cupful of cream. Stir until the sugar is melted, then boil, until a soft ball forms when a spoonful is dropped in cold water. Take from the fire and beat till thick, adding a cupful of pecan meats as thickening begins. Turn out on a buttered platter.

BUTTER SCOTCH

Half a cupful of butter, three tablespoonfuls of sugar, half a cupful of molasses, three tablespoonfuls of water. Boil until brittle when dropped into cold water. Pour into a buttered dish, and break into pieces when hard or drop on paraffin paper.
