- The dainty nightgown shown in the sketch is one of the simplest designs seen for a long time, and it is so easy to make that its details seem worth recording for the benefit of the woman who still has a few Christmas gifts to make or who will begin the task of home dressmaking and general sewing immediately after the Christmas holidays. The gown would be especially pleasing if made of washable satin, crepe metone or crepe de chine, although, of course, a fine cotton fabric may be used. If it is made entirely by hand so much the better.
- Two perfectly straight widths of material are used for the gown. There really need not be a seam except down each side from waist to hem, as the material may be
- folded and the neck hollowed out, leaving the shoulders uncut. The neck is held in with a bit of gathers. The very deep armholes are simply hemstitched and finished with a white ruffle. If the gown is made of cotton material, the ruffle may be of the self fabric hemstitched or of lace or embroidery. If of silk fabric ruffles of Gedgeette are very dainty and pretty.
- This gown can be made with a very small expenditure of time. Of course no pattern is required. The only things to be considered are the length and the selection of material that is wide enough to make two lengths adequate for the gown. A ribbon draws it in at the waist line.
- There is much to be said in favor of silk undergarments, even for the woman who is economically inclined. Very cheap silk, of course, is a poor investment, but where a good quality is purchased it gives splendid wear and silk garments may be laundered by the owner.
