OUTWITTING A MUTINY.

In his article on the Life-Savers of the Goodwin Sands, Walter Wood, the English sea writer, tells of a case where a mutiny was brought to a sudden end by the mate of the vessel who deliberately imperilled his ship in order to bring the life-savers to his aid.

"Once a ship was deliberately imperilled on the Goodwins for subtle reasons. She was bound from Hamburg, and was off the English coast when her crew mutinied, and murdered and threw overboard the captain and his son. The mate was spared because he was essential to the navigation of the vessel. He was ordered to make for the North Sea; but heavy weather forced him into the Downs. Purposely he ran perilously near the sands, knowing that instantly boatmen would put off from shore. The mutineers had no understanding of his motive, nor did they realize that they were doomed.
