ISLAND BOY NOW PRISONER IN GERMANY

Mrs. Daniel McPhee, Georgetown, received the following letter from her son, Somewhere in Belgium April 28th, 1916

Dear Mrs. McPhee:—Your gallant son Corpl. J. D. McPhee 76141 has been missing since the 20th when his platoon was holding one of the craters. They were under heavy shell fire all day, large numbers were killed or wounded and a few captured. It will be some time before we know who the men were who were captured, so we must hope that he was among the number. Your son has been in my company since we formed in Vancouver and was always one of my best men. Calm, cool under fire he could always be counted upon for any duty. You all have my deepest sympathy and it will be a long time before I will forget your gallant boy.

A telegram received since this letter was written states that he is now a prisoner in Germany.
