Sharp Decrease In Butter Stocks

OTTAWA, Nov. 4 (CP)—Canadian stocks of butter showed a sharp decrease on Nov. 1 as compared with a month ago, according to figures for nine cities released by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

While the figures for nine cities do not cover the entire storages of butter in Canada they are a close indication of the trend. On Nov. 1 there were stored in these cities 26,622,172 pounds of butter compared with 32,151,922 pounds on Oct. 1 and 43,794,530 on Nov. 1, 1941.

In addition there were 80,068 pounds of dairy butter in storage on Nov. 1. Canada is well stocked with cheese. In the nine cities 50,383,292 pounds were in storage on Nov. 1 as compared with 51,717,555 on Oct. 1 and 36,068,826 a year ago.

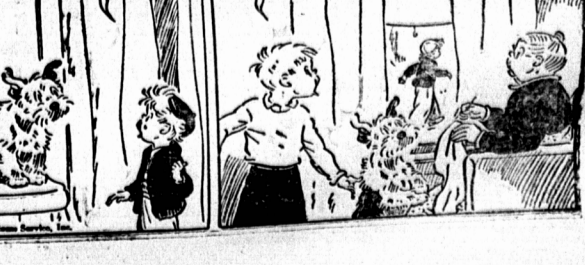

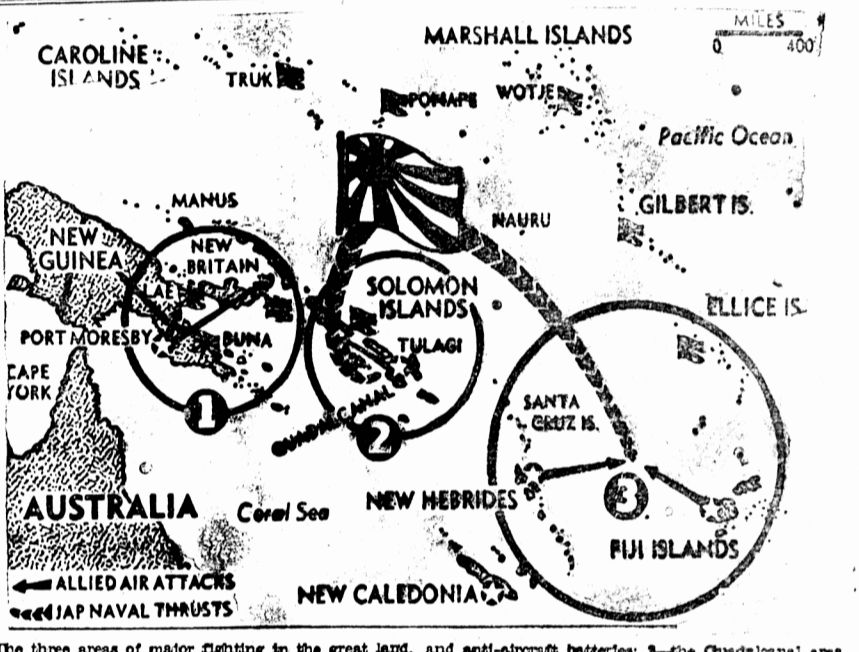
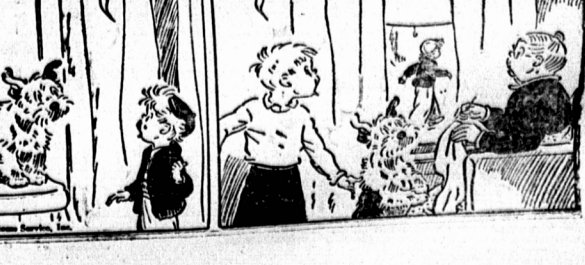
