N. Y. Stock Market Speeds On Downgrade

NEW YORK, May 19 — (AP)—A slowly declining stock market picked up speed on the downgrade in late trading today.
Final prices showed losses of fractions to 2 points or more, with most at the day's lowest levels.
Sales of 840,000 shares compared with 740,000 Wednesday.
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks lost .5 of one point at 63.2. The industrial section showed the largest setback, with the rails a runner-up and utilities in number three place.
Bethlehem and Republic Steel each touched new lows for the 1949 during the day although Beth Steel came back a trifle to end 5-8 down at 27 5-8. Republic was 1-2 lower at 20 1-2.
Others down included U. S. Steel, General Motors, Chrysler, Studebaker and Santa Fe.

At Montreal
MONTREAL, May 19 — (CP)— Losses outnumbered gains about two-to-one during listless trading on the Montreal stock exchange and curb market today. Mines also retreated as trading was fairly active.

Once again industrial sales were approximately the same as yesterday's with a turnover of only 25-900 shares. Mines, on the other hand, totalled 118,300 shares, an increase of 32,300 shares over the previous session.
Closing averages showed banks off .07 at 27.77; utilities up .1 at 72.4; industrials off .1 at 119.2; papers off .33 at a new low of 25.60 and golds off .54 at 64.16.

There were 168 issues traded on the two Montreal exchanges today of which only 29 were higher than yesterday. Sixty-eight were lower and 71 remained unchanged. Five new highs and 19 new lows were established.

Metals, papers and western oils were on a sharp decline as utilities and steels were mixed.
Aluminum was down 5-8 and closed at a year's low of 50 3-8. Both Consolidated Smelters and Hudson Bay Mining fell 1-2 while Noranda dipped 1-4. International Nickel, with a turnover of 3,565 shares, moved ahead 3-8 to 37.

TORONTO, May 19 — (CP)— A few producing gold issues showed small gains in an otherwise weak session on the Toronto stock exchange today.

Activity continued at the slow pace of recent sessions as western oils slipped downwards. Base metals held firm on mixed gains and losses.

Lake Shore gained in senior golds and Dome dipped a fraction while some junior producers showed gains ranging up to 30 cents. Smaller issues were on the downside in quiet dealings with several stocks touching new lows for the year.

Giant Yellowknife, Campbell, Malartic, Madson, Pickle Crow and San Antonio were among the gainers.

Calgary and Edmonton lost 50 cents at \$5.35 in a downward western oil group. Anglo-Canadian, Royalite, Okalta and Pacific Petroleum showed losses.
