LONDON, April 29 (Special)—Lord Alfred Bruce Douglas was found guilty in the Central Criminal Court of having libelled his father-in-law, Colonel F. H. Custance, of Weston Hall, near Nowick.

Lord Alfred, through counsel expressed regret and undertook not to repeat the libel. He was bound over in £2,500 (£1,500) to keep the peace and come up for judgment if called upon.

PEKIN, April 29 (Special)—Negotiations between the Ministry of Finance and the representatives of the five Power "consortium" have been in progress for some days, and it is understood that a loan contract is on the eve of signature. This is the long delayed "reorganization" loan for \$125,000,000, in which the American group was interested until it withdrew from the China field following President Wilson's announcement of the democratic administration policy. Representatives of the English, French, German, Russian and Japanese groups renewed negotiations on the old basis. This provides for foreign supervision of the salt gabelle, which China gives as security for the loan, and also a system of foreign and Chinese joint auditing to insure the proceeds of the loan going to the purposes for which the money is borrowed.

That President's Wilson's announcement of administration policy with regard to American participation in China's reorganization loan has resulted in the loss of that country of an interest approximately \$125,000,000 in China's great program of railway development was made clear by Mr. George Bronson, Rea, an American and publisher of the Far Eastern Review at Shanghai, who went to America as the accredited representative of Dr. Sun Yat-sen, president of the National Railway Corporation of China.

After devoting two months to an endeavor to induce American bankers and railway constructors to undertake the financing and construction of a great system of railways in China, Mr. Rea left for England to lay the matter before English and Continental capitalists. Before leaving Mr. Rea explained his reasons for believing the door of opportunity has been shut against American enterprise, and especially American manufacturers, by the President's proclamation.

LORD WOLSELEY AND CANADIANS

The Famous General's Complimentary Address to the Troops in 1870 Are Recalled

Lord Wolseley was more intimately associated with Canada, perhaps, than any other great British general since the days of Wolfe, and Canadians have always taken the keenest interest in his brilliant career. That is a common idea that Lord Wolseley is a common idea that Lord Wolseley was born, so to speak, with a field marshal's baton in his hand, but the fact is that he fought his way up step by step, for he entered the British army as an ensign at the age of 19. His father was a major, but it does not appear that Lord Wolseley had any other advantages to assist his promotion save his natural gifts as a soldier. He was a veteran of the Crimea and at the Siege of Sebastopol received the Legion of Honor, and was severely wounded. Later on he went to China and saw active service, receiving a medal and two clasps. Shortly after the Chinese War he was appointed Deputy Quartermaster General in Canada.

Training a Canadian Army
 The Trent affair gave scope to his remarkable organizing ability, for it devolved upon him to make the arrangements for conveying the British troops overland up the St. John Valley to the Riviere du Loup. He carried out his difficult duties with much success. In 1865 a camp of instruction was formed at La Prairie, and Colonel Wolseley was placed in command of the three battalions. A year later the Fenian Raid occurred, and the training that the 2,600 men had received under the British colonel was not by military critics. When the Red River Rebellion broke out in 1870 there was a demand from all parts of Canada that Colonel Wolseley should be given charge of the Canadian forces. How successfully he handled this situation need not be dwelt upon, but to show that Wolseley had as high an opinion of the Canadian militia as the volunteers had of him, it is interesting to quote from the farewell address he issued to the troops.

Canadian Fine Troops
 "In saying good-bye to you," he said, "I beg that each and all of you will accept my grateful recognition of your valuable services, and my thanks for the zeal you have displayed in carrying out my orders. I congratulate you upon the success of our expedition, which has secured to this country a peaceable solution of its late troubles. The credit for this success is due to the gallant soldiers I had at my back; upon you fell the labor of carrying the boats and heavy loads, a labor in which each officer and man vied with each other as to who should do the most. Nothing but that pluck for which British soldiers, whether born in the colonies or the Mother Country, are celebrated, could have carried you so successfully through the arduous advance upon this place. You had to carry upon your backs a heavy amount of supplies over no fewer than 47 portages making a total distance of seven miles, a feat unparalleled in our military annals. I can say without flattery that, though I have served with many armies in the field, I have never associated with a better set of men."

From Victory Unto Victory
 On his way home Colonel Wolseley was tendered a great reception at Montreal, his time not permitting him to receive a greeting at Toronto as the citizens had planned. Shortly after returning to England he was sent in command of the Ashanti campaign, and received the submission of the king at Comassie. For these services he was voted the thanks of Parliament, the sum of \$25,000, and created a K.C.B. As Sir Garnet Wolseley he was commander of the Egyptian expedition in 1882, which ended in the defeat of Arabi Pasha at Tel-el-Kharkh. He conducted the operations for the relief of Gordon and Khartoum, and on this occasion sent to Canada for a company of voyageurs, who were of great service to the Nile expedition, and received the public thanks of the commanding general before returning home. Lord Wolseley was a great soldier, and with Roberts and Kitchener, was one of the three greatest British generals since Wellington.

One For the Inspector
 Before Dr. Macnamara, the Canadian entered the British Parliament he was a schoolmaster, and inspector of duty sometimes fell his way.

OF SPECIAL INTEREST

NEW YORK, April 29 (Special)—This city is to spend \$8,000,000 more for its drinking water. Just when the new supply from the \$162,000,000 Catskill system is about to be tapped the city officials are preparing to spend more millions on the old Croton system by building a new filtration plant at the Jerome Park reservoir.

Commissioner Thompson, of the Department of Water Supply, recommended building the reservoir more than a year ago, but there were delays. The report of the engineers yesterday favors the building of the plant, agreeing with Commissioner Thompson that purification of the Croton water is necessary for the protection of the city. Controller Prendergast will make a report, based on the advice given by the engineers, and then the Board of Estimate is expected to authorize the appropriation.

NEW YORK, April 29 (Special)—That China is advancing rapidly in the science of aviation, and its army is already in advance of the United States in that regard, is the opinion of George M. Dyott, an aviator, who returned here on board the Minnetonka, of the Atlantic Transport line. "The Chinese government has put in an order with a large American firm manufacturing aeroplanes," said Mr. Dyott, "for eighty machines, and they have a large number of young men training as aviators." Mr. Dyott said that he is on his way to Mexico to give some demonstrations there, and hopes to obtain orders for machines from the Mexican government. From Mexico he will go to India, he said.

NEWPORT, R. I., April 29 (Special)—The advance of the icebergs under the warming influence of spring is noted in the report of the revenue cutter Seneca, now on ice patrol in the North Atlantic, which was received here by wireless.
 "The eastern limit of the bergs now is latitude 45.34 north, longitude 41.22 west," the message said. "The southern limit is latitude 44.30 north, longitude 48.30.13 west. Large bergs are reported by the steamer Numidian thirty miles north and west of Flemish Capes. Heavy fog on Banks."
