REV. DAVID SUTHERLAND

As briefly announced in yesterday's Morning Guardian, Rev. David Sutherland, the beloved pastor of Zion Presbyterian church passed to the life beyond at an early hour on Friday morning.

He gave his life to the cause and the Master whom he served, and like a faithful sentinel he died at his post. By his congregation he was greatly beloved, and many of them could not restrain their tears on learning that he was no more.

Mr. Sutherland was a man of more than ordinary gifts. He was learned, well-read and had fine literary taste and yet his discourses were brought within the understanding of all.

He was the friend and helper of every good cause. He won the sympathy of the poor by the Christian sympathy he felt for them.

The deceased minister was born at Bruan, Cathness, Scotland, 11th July, 1859. He was the eldest son of Mr. Alexander Sutherland of that place.

To the bereaved wife, four children and his aged parents, he has left the rich legacy of a noble and beautiful life.
