THE COOK'S CORNER

SAVORY LIVER

- 1-2 pound liver
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped onion
- 1-2 green pepper, chopped
- 2 tablespoons pure vegetable shortening
- 1-2 cup chopped, canned mushrooms
- 1-2 teaspoon salt
- Dash of pepper
- 1 large (24 ounce) can cooked spaghetti in tomato sauce with cheese.

METHOD—Cut liver into slender, small strips. Cook onion and pepper in vegetable shortening. Add mushrooms and brown slightly. Add liver, then cover and heat slowly eight minutes or until cooked thoroughly. Season with salt and pepper. Heat spaghetti and turn out on platter. Top with liver mixture. Sprinkle with grated Parmesan cheese if desired.

OLD-FASHIONED BOILED DRESSING

- Two tablespoons flour, 4 teaspoons sugar, 2 teaspoons salt, 1-2 teaspoons dry mustard, a dash of cayenne pepper, 2 eggs, or 4 egg-yolks, slightly beaten, 1 cup scalded milk, 1-2 cup vinegar, 1 cup sour cream.

Mix dry ingredients and add to slightly beaten eggs. Add milk and vinegar and cook over hot water, stirring constantly, until mixture thickens. Cool quickly and add sour cream. Store in covered jar in refrigerator.

Yield: About 3 cups.

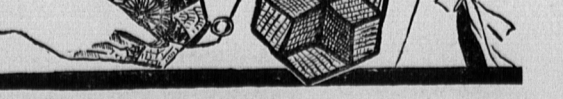
