STUDENT CONCERT
One of the most delightful student concerts ever given at Mount Allison was rendered on Friday evening, December 18th in Beethoven Hall. The different departments represented were the Piano, Vocal Culture, Pipe Organ, Violin, Orchestra and Oratory, thus making a program of great variety and interest. The performers represented a territory almost as varied as the character of the perfect music. Miss Gertrude Borden, Wolfville, N. S., Miss Nellie Myers, St. John, N. B., and Miss Jessie Allen, Bayfield, N. B., all rendered piano solos with true artistic feeling. Miss Lennie Lusby, Amherst, N. S., Miss Cladie Smith, Sackville, N. B., and the Misses Bessie and Maie Redden, Canning, N. S., gave violin solos; while the orchestra with 35 instruments rendered Pleyel's Allegro Op. 8, with exceptional volume and precision. This department of the Conservatory, under the able management of Miss Ayer, is attracting more students than one teacher is able to manage. Arrangements are being made to secure an assistant for next term. The orchestral effect produced by the usual combination of instruments provided by the pipe organ, grand piano, double brass, cellos, violas, flutes three kettle drums and 25 violins was pronounced by a gentleman present, who had just come from some of the concerts given by professionals in Montreal, as equal to the best he had heard.
