THE COMING UNITED STATES ELECTIONS.

Early in November there will take place throughout the United States what is the equivalent of a general election in this country.

There is great interest in the coming national elections this year because of the insurgent movement in the hitherto dominant Republican party.

So far nothing has occurred to radically alter the situation since the state election in Maine some weeks ago, when the Democrats captured that old-time Republican stronghold.

MARITIME UNION AGAIN.

Bishop Worrell of Halifax, when on St. John the other day, expressed himself to The Telegraph as in favor of Maritime Union.

"I must say that I would like to see the Provinces of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia united as one.

Reminded that Maritime Union had been long advocated by some persons, but that nothing had come of it, His Lordship said, "Yes, but Prince Edward Island has always been the reluctant Province.

All of which is easy to say but not quite so easy to bring about. What are the chances of New Brunswick uniting in a legislative union with Nova Scotia in face of the fact that on the principle of representation by population the Atlantic Province would be in absolute control of the Government and Legislature?

But a day or two before Bishop Worrell was thus expressing himself in favor of Maritime Union, Premier Haszard, then visiting in the West was reported to have made the statement that Prince Edward Island would never have entered upon union with Canada had our people known that our representation would be taken away as it has been.

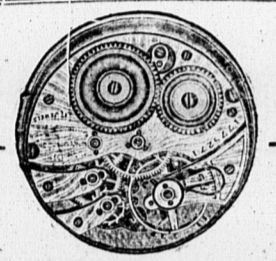
