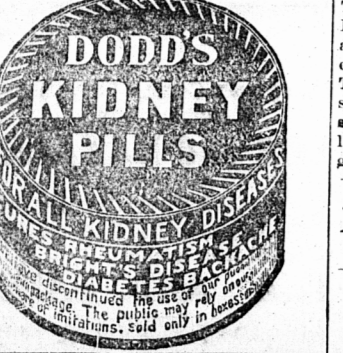

S. S. Electra arrived here on Friday from Pictou with 400 bbls. flour and sundries for Matthew & McLean.

The sch. Foaming Billow, Capt. Wrayton, from Halifax which went aground off here is now being hauled ashore and repaired. The damage is not very serious.

The genial Capt. McLeod, has arrived safely from Boston with his schooner Blanche M. Thorborn, having made a very quick passage.

The death occurred in Charlottetown, Mass., Sunday, Dec. 3, of James, beloved son of the late Angus and Elizabeth McDonald, Souris. Deceased was thirty years of age.

The harbor has a very busy aspect at the present time. From eight to twelve vessels are in port, some loading, some fishing and others laying up for the winter. The schr. Three Bells being loaded by J. J. Hughes & Co has about finished her cargo and the schrs. Golden Rule and Cyril only want a few hundred bushels to complete their cargoes. Sch. Madeira is also making much progress. The three latter are being loaded by Matthew & McLean. The schr. Jubilee is about ready for cargo and the Bucksport vessel is unloading ballast. Sch. Yukon the only fishing vessel now in port is doing remarkably well. She came in Saturday evening with a large quantity of fish and intends fishing till the ice makes its appearance, which shows good results this time of year for the eastern winter port.
