Stock Markets At A Glance

WINNIPEG, May 22 (CP)—Rye futures prices moved in a relatively narrow range in light, nervous dealings on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today.

CHICAGO, May 22 (AP)—All active grain futures displayed strength in quiet trading today. Some buying was based on action of the Senate banking and currency committee with respect to office of price administration legislation. Traders believed that legislation extending the price control act would sharply limit the O. P. A.'s powers.

TORONTO, May 22 (CP)—From a slow and uncertain start, the Toronto stock market improved as the session advanced today. At the close base metals were up one-half to three-quarters of a point, the index and the golds and western oils were narrowly lower. The turnover totalled 185,000 shares, the smallest volume of the year.

MONTREAL, May 22 (CP)—Individual strong spots abounded in the list board today on the stock exchange and curb market, notably in utilities, liquors, industrials and metals. Industrials went to a new all-time top in the indices, papers were weaker.

WINNIPEG Electric issues were featured in utilities. Also Power Corporation, which is interested in the utility, was in demand. The stocks displayed some of the strength and activity they showed recently when the Winnipeg City Council made an unofficial offer for the electric company.

NEW YORK, May 22 (AP)—Ralls and low-priced utilities led the third successive upturn in the stock market today with gains ranging from more than two points predominant at the close.

As it was the Associated Press 60-stock average advanced .05 of a point to 80.5, equalling the bull market peak of April 20.

Canadian Pacific was up 3-8 and Distillers Seagram 1-4. McEvoy's lost as much and Dome Mines slipped 1-8. Hiram Walker lost 1/2. Lake Shore, the stock, gained 3/4.

Volume for the day totalled 1,500,000 shares, best since May 10. This compared with 1,250,000 shares Tuesday.

As one came from the barn and started toward the hen coop, the birds came running from all directions. There was a clacking, high-pitched babel of voices—similar to the noises made by all forms of animal life, higher or lower, when food is in the offering. It was fun to take handfuls of the cream, hard grains and scatter them widely so that all the company could get a fair share. For here are birds and ingrate social gradations and inhibitions, in hen society as in human. Feeding the hens was a pleasant, easy job's-end task. And as one listened to the excited hungry talk change to the contentment of satisfaction, a lad glimpsed the fundamental importance of good in life's scheme.
