## THE CAUSE AT HOME

### Quarterly Session of the Grand Division, P.E.I.

A Temperance Rally Proposed in Charlottetown on Nell Dow's Birthday, March 20—Increase in Membership.

The Grand Division of Sons of Temperance, of P. E. Island, met in quarterly session in Old English Hall on Wednesday, the 14th inst., the G. W. P. W. J. Kirby, presiding. On account of the bad state of the travelling, the attendance of representatives from a distance was not large. The session opened at 1 o'clock, P. M., and was chiefly occupied in receiving and discussing the reports of the Grand Officers.

The report of the G. W. P. was a very able and instructive document and was well received, but as the Grand Division ordered it to be sent to the newspapers for publication, it is not necessary to give a synopsis of it here. The report of the Grand Scribe detailed at considerable length the workings of the order during the last quarter. From it we learn that the order is not only holding its own, but is doing aggressive work.

Three new divisions have been organized during the quarter in places where no temperance society existed previously. The present membership of the order is reported at 1800, an increase of about 200 during the quarter.

Yet we have much to rejoice over; it is not matter for rejoicing that the fact of this one district voting as it did created a surprise. Does it not show that the country expects that a large majority would vote for prohibition.

The G. W. G. in moving the vote of thanks to the choir hinted that he was once a choir boy himself, and would not be satisfied till that worthy gentleman took his seat at the organ and in excellent voice sang two stanzas of "Jesus lover of my Soul."

So ended a very enjoyable day's proceedings, and we trust that the almighty hammer blows dealt at the traffic will contribute in some measure towards knocking the few remaining props from under that iniquitous fabric—the liquor business.

## ANARCHISTS AGAIN! General Liability

### A Reign of Terror Inaugurated in Paris.

PARIS, Feb. 20—Another bomb explosion took place this morning in a small hotel. The proprietor and two lodgers were injured. The anarchist who left the bomb has escaped. Great excitement prevails. People are losing confidence in the ability of the police to put to an end these anarchist crimes. There is now no doubt as to the existence of an extensive and active anarchist propaganda. All high officials are in constant fear of assassination.

### A Frederictonian Fied.

FREDERICTON, Feb. 20—A great sensation has been created here. George M. Davis, a popular druggist died on Sunday and has gone to the States. He has been discovered to have forged the name of F. P. Thompson, his brother-in-law and a prominent politician, to about forty notes aggregating \$8000. He also forged the name of J. D. Finney M. P. P., another brother-in-law to over \$4000 more. The paper notes were all discovered by brokers; none went to the banks. Efforts probably will be made to arrest Davis.

### Settles Manitoba School Question.

OTTAWA, Feb. 20—The Supreme Court this morning gave judgment that the Dominion Government has no power to interfere with Manitoba school legislation. The powers of provinces in the matter of education are now finally defined.
