Who Die Annually in Canada Impure Milk The Primary Cause

OTTAWA, June 13.—A number of valuable papers on subjects relating to the medical profession were given at today's session of the Canadian Medical Association.

Dr. C. J. O. Hastings of Toronto, in a paper on the improvement of pure milk, read before the section on public health, declared that impure milk was primarily responsible for the loss of 15,000 of the 30,000 children who die annually in Canada.

This afternoon members of the association were as guests of the C. P. R. to Caledonia Springs.

This evening at a general meeting of the association Dr. Rislan Russell of London, England, gave an address on medicine and Dr. J. C. Munro of Boston, Mass., spoke on Surgical Rights of the Public.

The formation of a Canadian Ambulance and Red Cross Association was advocated in a paper read by Lieutenant Colonel Jones of Ottawa's before a section on military medicine. A committee was named to consider the formation of the association.

SEDITION NOT WANTED IN INDIA

Suppression Of Newspaper Action In Cases Of Bomb Outrages.

SIMLA, June 13.—The Vice-Royal Council after strong speeches by Lord Minto, Viceroy of India, and other members of the Council, emphasizing the urgency of dealing with seditious outbreaks, yesterday adopted two emergency measures. The first is known as the explosives bill, which provides stern measures against bomb outrages and conspiracies; the second, the press bill, empowers the suppression and confiscation of newspapers inciting to criminal acts.

Lord Minto was careful to explain that both of these bills should be regarded as exceptional measures to meet an exceptional situation. He added that if they were found to be not strong enough, some measure more severe would be adopted.
