Stock Markets At A Glance

CHICAGO, Oct. 22 — (AP) — Grain futures today continued rally that began Saturday, with all grains except corn climbing well over a cent a bushel at times.

WINNIPEG, Oct. 22 — (CP) — A brisk rally in the last half of a moderately active session on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today day upped rye futures from 1 1/4 to 2 3/8 cents. Buying by commission houses, locals and for American account found offerings light. Firmness at Chicago aided the local market.

TORONTO, Oct. 22 — (CP) — The Toronto Stock Market was strong in spots and fairly active in all groups in today's operations. The Base Metals and Western Oils shares finished higher and the golds took a moderate loss after the golds had shown a margin of gains at noon.

NEW YORK, Oct. 22 — (AP) — Selected bulls, industrials and utilities pushed upward in today's market although demand was relatively light and many leaders suffered from neglect.

The Associated Press 60 stock average was up 4 of a point at 72.8 where it was only one-tenth under its recent 8-year peak.

MONTREAL, Oct. 22 — (CP) — Golds extended their current up-swing and went to a new top in the indices in transfers today on the Stock Exchange and Curb Market. In the balance of the pivotal groups, utilities were up on average and papers, industrials and banks were lower. Trading tempo was slow at the opening due to the victory loan campaign but picked up near the bell.
