Livestock Market

(Canadian Press)

MONTREAL, Dec. 11.—There were 102 cattle, 90 calves, 687 hogs and 167 sheep and lambs for sale on the two Montreal live stock markets today. Trading in cattle and lambs was dull and sales were slow at about steady prices. A couple of loads of good steers were offered and were not sold at time of writing. Common to medium cows were sold around \$3.50 to \$6. Canners \$3.50 and cutters up to \$4.50. Common bulls were firm at \$5 for light yearling to \$5.50 for heavier bulls. Calves were steady at \$5.75 for grassers to \$14.50 for good suckers. Lambs were unchanged, \$12.00 was the standard quotation for hogs fed and watered.
