

MOTOR NOTES

When using the self-starter be sure that the spark is retarded, as a back kick may wreck the mechanism. This is not necessary if the car is equipped with a magneto if the engine starts best when magneto spark is advanced.

When following other cars on a crowded country road, watch out for a sudden stop. Get in the habit of running the car slightly off the road, if there is room, so that if the brakes do not hold you will be in no danger of hitting the car ahead.

Best results can be secured from a motor cooling system by keeping the radiator cells free from foreign matter. Particularly on long trips over bad roads the interstices of the radiator are packed with dirt and mud, retaining the heat which should be dissipated in radiation.

Be careful that the spare tire on the rear of the car does not hide part of the number plate and that the plate is properly lighted at night. The police in many sections are enforcing the law very strictly, and you will find that paying a fine is a very expensive way to learn of such mistakes.

Many cars have the headlamps fastened to the fenders and if these latter are at all loose, vibration is increased to such an extent that frequent replacement of the bulbs is necessary. One should make a periodic inspection of the fender supports to see that they are tight.

A deposit of dust on the reflector or lens often cuts down the light to a marked degree. The owner should make a weekly habit of wiping the dust from these parts. While doing this it is a good plan to inspect the cable connection. Vibration often loosens it and the poor contact results in a loss of light and waste of current.

In many cases water and dirt in the fuel system cause almost endless trouble, which may very likely be attributed to the engine proper. Dirt will clog the minute crevices in the carburetor, causing numerous peculiar symptoms of trouble to appear. Many cars have no provision, except a metal strainer in the tank, for preventing the entrance of dirt into the fuel system. It was suggested that the owners of cars so equipped fit a trap in the gasoline line. All the larger manufacturers of carburetors have devices of this kind in stock. Usually they are placed directly in the gasoline line, near the carburetor, or again they may be located at the bottom of the tank. The trap catches all dirt and water and for its effective operation it is essential that it be drained at intervals of not longer than five weeks.

ena and religion of spiritualism says he thought, read and experimented on the subject for thirty years. Contrasting the precision of earthly science, he says: "The same circle may assemble with the same medium in the same room under the same physical condition and meet with utter failure on Monday, but achieve complete success on Tuesday. The same medium may, one day, deliver a message which proves absolutely true and the next day, even in some cases during the same sitting, deliver another message which is a detailed fabrication. The only reasonable explanation of these disconcerting variations is in my opinion that while earthly conditions are constant, there are conditions unseen on the other side which vary and affect the results. The skeptic may peer at the failures but they are in truth reassuring, for if fraud were at work there is no reason why it should fail one day and succeed another. Variations are in my experience even more marked in private circles than where a paid medium is employed. "I have a little book called 'Some Reminiscences' by Alfred Smedley. It is a record of experiments carried out by circle of earnest inquirers and if no other book on the subject existed this would suffice as to events on that occasion. Those who are acquainted with the literature are aware how fully detailed is the evidence and how trustworthy the names which vouch for the results. Within the last year or so five works have appeared—Lodge's, Raymond Barrett's Threshold Unseen, Crawford's Psychological Phenomena, Hill's Psychological Investigation, Gerald Balfour's

Ear of Dionysus—which greatly strengthen the case which was very strong before. Of these five authors it may be remarked that there are university professors accustomed to careful psychological research. "I know of no other branch of science which has claimed the attention of so distinguished a set of earnest students as Crookes, Lodge, Dr. Hodgson, Professor Sedgwick, Sir William Barrett, W. T. Stead, Gerald Balfour, A. Thury Hill, Mores, Gurney and other psychical researchers. If the conclusion of these men after thorough and patient investigation are to be set aside, it would seem impossible that anything should be established by human testimony." Doyle says the religious side of spiritualism seems far more vital than the scientific side.
