GRAIN

WINNIPEG, March 17.—(CP)—Increased European political tension brought out nervous trading on Winnipeg wheat futures market today to shoot prices up about two cents although offerings encountered at the peak eased part of the gains. Closing quotations were 1 3-8-1 5-8 higher, May at 60 1-4, July 61 and Oct. 62.
 Operations were fairly brisk throughout although volume was not as large as in some of the previous sessions. Most of the support was credited to exporters and overseas houses.
 Canadian wheat export sales were close to 300,000 bushels, most of which was worked from the Atlantic seaboard. Nos. 1, 2 and 3 Northern grades were mentioned prominently for shipment to the United Kingdom and Norway.
 In the coarse grains pit operations were mixed as prices exhibited strength in sympathy with wheat. Cash wheat trading was thin.

Currencies

NEW YORK, March 17.—(AP)—Foreign exchange markets worked uncertainly today as Chancellor Hitler swung triumphantly through new German territory.
 While the spot Pound Sterling declined only 1-4 of a cent to 4.68 1-8, the discount on 90-day forward Sterling widened to 2 cents. This was 3-8 cents above yesterday's discount and banking quarters termed the jump "exceptional."
 The Swiss franc, continued in one of the widest breaks in months lost another .02 1-2 of a cent to 22.65 in terms of the United States dollar.
 The French franc held its ground well with a loss of .00 1-4 of a cent to 2.64 5-8. The Belgas was .00 1-2 of a cent down with the guilder unchanged. Canadian funds closed at a discount of 33-64 compared with 15-32 yesterday.
 MONTREAL, March 17.—(CP)—Pound Sterling advanced 1-32 to 4.70 5-8 on Montreal foreign exchange today while the United States dollar pushed up 1-16 to 1.00 17-32. French francs retreated slightly and closed at 2.66 3-32.
