MAN DROWNED IN MONCTON RESERVOIR

MONCTON, July 27.—Henry C. Leblanc, aged 37, son of Cyril Leblanc, of St. Mary's county, was drowned this morning in the new city reservoir, about four miles out on the McLaughlin road. Leblanc and two companions went into the reservoir bathing, neither being able to swim. The water was not deep and the men were simply wading around when Leblanc fell into a deep hole made by the removal of a stump and sank. Timely assistance might have saved the men, but it was not forthcoming, as the men with Leblanc were unable to swim. Deceased was employed with the McManus company, on the construction of the dam. The body was recovered and will be sent to his home in St. Mary's to-morrow for burial. No inquest was held.

LONDON, July 26.—The members of the Imperial cadet corps, selected by Lord Roberts to represent the Mother Country as guests of the Dominion government, left Liverpool yesterday by the C. P. R. Empress of Britain.
