WHOLEMEAL FRUIT LOAF Have two breakfasts of wholemeal: 1-2 lb of currants, 1-2 lb of sugar; 4 ozs. of butter; 1-2 lb of ground rice; 2 ozs. of peel; 1 egg; 2 teaspoonful of baking powder; 1 teaspoonful of bicarbonate of soda; 1 gill of milk; flavoured.

MAIDS-O-HONOUR Have 1 tablespoonful of butter; 1 heaped tablespoonful of corn-flour; 1 heaped tablespoonful of ground rice; 1 heaped tablespoonful of self-raising flour; 1-2 teaspoonful of baking powder; 2 tablespoonful of caster sugar; 1 egg; pinch of salt; jam.

SPICED PRUNE CAKE This is one of Mrs. H. M. Altken's recipes: One-half cup shortening; 3-4 cup white sugar; 1-4 cup corn syrup; 2 eggs; 1 teaspoon baking soda; 1-2 cup thick sour milk; 2 cups bread-flour; 1-2 teaspoon salt; 1 teaspoon cream of tartar; 1 teaspoon each: cloves, cinnamon, nutmeg and allspice; 2 cups cooked chopped prunes.

In a recent magazine article a father tells how he tried to prepare his daughter for life by treating her with almost inhuman cruelty. He urges other parents to use this same harsh method in bringing up their children so that they may be hardened to meet whatever misfortunes may befall them.
