and gratitude. From that very moment I knew that the organization of a French Canadian corps would be unanimously sanctioned and that we might begin the formation of the new regiment. We must give our warmest thanks to the Prime Minister, Sir Robert Borden, for the precious assistance he accorded us. We still remain as the poet said, "The sons of Brittany and descendants of the great warriors of La Belle France."

Mr. Marechal then referred to the request made by the old Emperor, Francis Joseph, to Pope Pious X. for benediction for his army when he was preparing to throw his battalions on innocent Serbia. The Emperor asked for God's blessing on the Austrian cavalry and infantry which had not enough soldiers at Ansterlitz and Sadowa but which was today being slaughtered and cut up by the French and Russian soldiers." He remarked that in the heat of his speech he had forgotten that only ten minutes were allowed and he finished: "Today we are sending soldiers to help the Mother Country. We are only doing our duty and fulfilling our promises. Our brave young men shall fight the common enemy, smash the infamous and cruel Bavarian, destroy the enemy of civilization, and let us hope, carry our flag into the very heart of the capital of the enemy."

Sir Lomer Gouin made a thrilling appeal to the people of Quebec to join the new regiment.

AGREED WITH THE PREMIER.

Mr. J. M. Tullier, leader of the Conservative party in the province of Quebec, remarked that at the conclusion of the speech of Sir Lomer Gouin that in the past he had very seldom sided with the Provincial Prime Minister, but on an occasion so important as that which had led to the present gathering, he could fully approve of the actions of the Provincial Government and he was proud to
