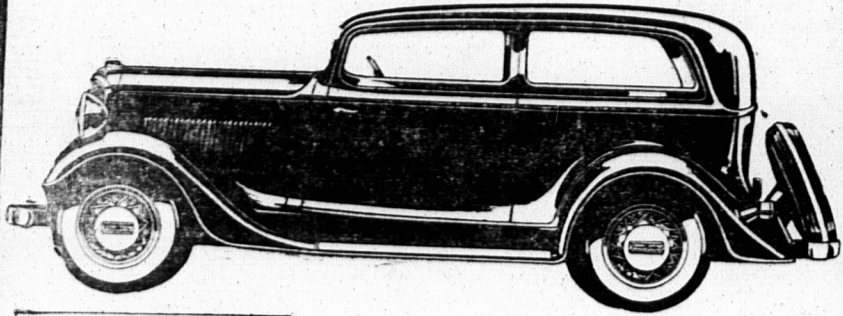

BUSINESS AT STANDSTILL IN BARBADOS

City Slowly Recovering From Series Of Riots Staged By Laborers.

BRIDGETOWN, Barbados, July 29.—(CP Cable)—Business and public transport was at a standstill tonight in Bridgetown as the city slowly recovered from a succession of riots staged by laborers as a protest against deportation of a Trinidad native.

Armed guards and marines from the British Warship Apollo patrolled the entire island. Isolated looting was reported from the interior but the outbreaks in which six were killed and 21 injured seemingly had ceased.

The disorders followed a month after oil fields and other workers in another West Indies island, Trinidad, had staged a series of bitter and bloody battles with police there. Fourteen were killed and scores wounded.

PORT OF SPAIN, Trinidad, July 29.—(CP Cable)—Clement Payne, Trinidad man whose deportation from Barbados was followed by a series of riots in which six laborers were killed, was fined \$50 for having forbidden literature in his possession, police announced today.
