His Remarks at St. George's Banquet in Halifax

HALIFAX, April 27.—(Special).—Major General Parsons at St. George's banquet said he was glad to know the feeling of Canada tended toward the organization of rifle associations and he favored regular visits of the Canadian Militia to Aldershot and other great military centres as beneficial for both.

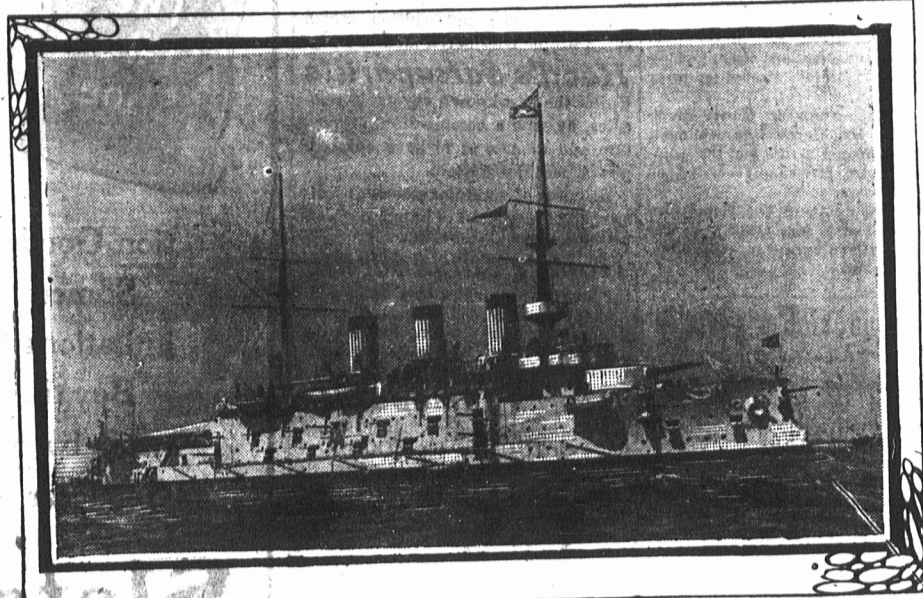

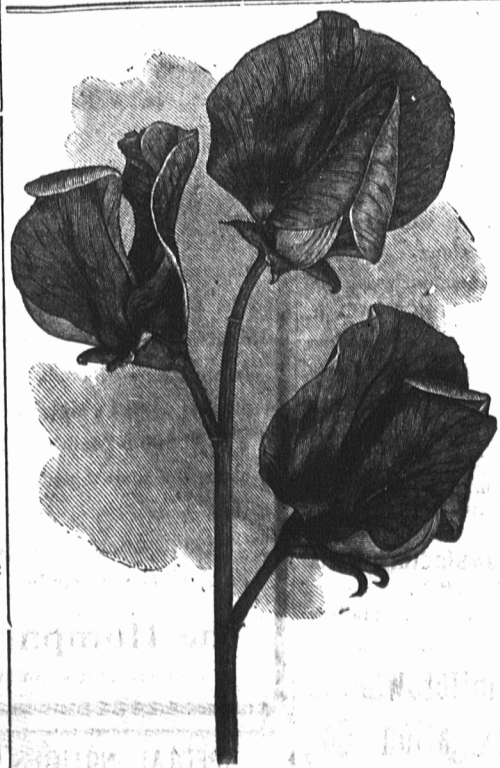
