BUTTER AND CHEESE.

Speaking of the Liverpool market, Hodgson Bros.' circular of January 14th, says: "Cheese has only been in moderate request, and must be reported a shade easier. With an improvement in demand more firmness would be shown, as stocks on hand are not excessive. We quote to-day, finest coloured Canadian September and October, 49s to 50s; white 49s to 49s 6d; August Canadian, coloured and white, 44s 6d to 47s; finest States, white and coloured 47s 6d to 49s. Early makes are in demand from 37s to 42s, also lower grades at 28s to 34s per cwt."

Hodgson Bros.' circular of the 24th inst., from Liverpool, says of butter: "With more liberal arrivals there has been more disposition to meet buyers, but demand has not been brisk. We quote to-day, fancy fresh made Canadian creamery, in boxes, 96s to 102s; grade below, 84s to 96s; finest States, 86s to 90s; finest ladies imitation creameries and choice Canadian dairies sell steadily from 68c to 75c; lower grades from 60s to 66s; finest Danish, 100s to 112s; Australian, 94s to 102s; Cork firsts, 105s; seconds, 101s; thirds, 84s per cwt."

"DEATH TO THE JEWS"

The trial of the action brought by Madame Henry against the editor of the Republicque Francaise for libelling her deceased husband was opened in the Paris assize court yesterday. A crowd assembled back of the palace of justice headed by a cripple with naked feet and M. Gurin, president of the anti-semitic league and cheered for the army and cried "Death to the Jews." The police dispersed the gathering.

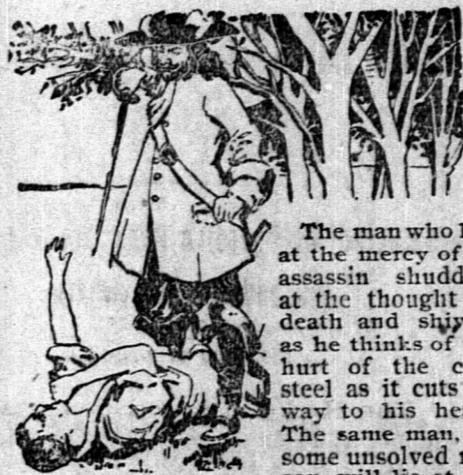
