(Continued from Page One) yet, and you know yourself how, by technicalities the second division was held up for four months through little petty haggling on the question of motor trucks, etc., etc.

"So far as I am aware you exercised the same control and direction over the forces in Great Britain during the first year as subsequently."

SIR ROBERT BORDEN ASKS FOR RESIGNATION.

Over a week later Sir Robert Borden requested the resignation of Sir Sam Hughes in the following terms:

Ottawa, Ont., Nov. 9, 1916.

Dear General Hughes:—During your absence I have given very careful consideration to your letter of the 1st inst., and I must express my deep regret that you are not fit to address to me, as head of the Government, a communication of that nature.

I do not intend to dwell upon the instances, some of which are still under consideration, in which you have acted without authority or consultation in matters more or less important.

But more than that your letter is couched in such terms that it cannot overlook or exempt it. I take strong exception not only to statements which it contains but to its general character and tone.

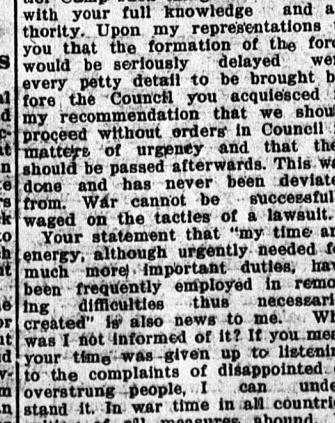
