**APPOINTMENT CREATES SURPRISE**

LONDON, Sept. 5. (Special)—The appointment of General Savoff as a delegate in the negotiations between Bulgaria and Turkey has created surprise at Constantinople, as he commanded the Bulgarian armies in Thrace.

The Turkish army, according to late advices, is strengthening its position west of the River Maritza and has now occupied Xanthi. It seems likely that Bulgaria will lose the greater part of Thrace, as well as Adrianople.

It is understood that the Bulgarian delegates will devote themselves to obtaining assured commercial access to the Aegean littoral, which is endangered by the Turkish occupation of Thrace.

**BYRAN'S PEACE PROJECT APPROVED**

THE HAGUE, Sept. 5. (Special)—The Interparliamentary Council at its first meeting here discussed a resolution proposed by Mr. Richard Bartholdt, of Missouri, declaring that the conference "approves of the project of the United States Secretary of State, Mr. Bryan, whereby the nations bind themselves to submit disputes for investigation by an impartial commission before resorting to hostilities, and requests the governments to enter into negotiations to secure such an arrangement."

The debate disclosed a unanimity of sentiment in favor of the general idea but differences of opinion as to whether or not the proposed text of the treaty should be approved.

Finally Mr. Bartholdt's motion was adopted in an amended form, expressing heartiest approval of the idea and requesting the Permanent Committee on Arbitration to take it under consideration and incorporate it in the committee's proposals.

**ZION CONGRESS OPENS AT VIENNA**

VIENNA, Sept. 5. (Special)—The eleventh Zionist congress has been opened here in the presence of nearly ten thousand people. Delegates to the number of 550 from all parts of the world are in attendance. They are some notable absentees, however, including Dr. Max Nordau.

The congress will extend over eight days. It will deal mainly with the work performed since the last congress.

Professor Warburg, of Berlin, delivered the inaugural address, in which he paid tribute to the memory of Dr. Theodor Herzl, founder of the Zionist movement, and incidentally remarked that Zionism would contribute considerably toward the development of the Turkish nation.

The business meetings will begin tomorrow. The Russian delegates, numbering 130, are holding a separate conference on a propaganda in Russia, as such gatherings are not permitted in that country. The women Zionists are also holding a separate conference.
