THE Guardian is pleased to learn that John K. Minchin son of Archibald Minchin, Milton, Ontario has almost recovered from his numerous wounds received while in active service in South Africa. He was struck by no less than six bullets, one of which he will carry during the rest of his life. Mr. Minchin is a first cousin of Mr. David Minchin cheese maker, New Perth and a grandson of John Kaneen Esq. of the same place.

It is of interest to know that there lives at New Perth one of those interesting personages who acts as a connecting link between the past and the present. Mrs. Minchin relict of the late Daniel Minchin is in her 94th year and in full possession of all her faculties. She distinctly remembers being present when the first steamer was launched on the Clyde. At the age of eight she left her native city of Greenock for Canada on the Brig Curia at that time commanded by her father Capt. Archibald Ferguson. About three hundred passengers arrived, many of whom settled at Marshfield and Belfast.

It is doubtful if any mother in the Maritime Provinces occupies the proud position held by Mrs. Alex McRae, Waterside Cottage, Pownal. Mrs. McRae has the honor of having sent forth three of her sons to battle in South Africa during the late war. Her eldest son F. B. McRae was present at Paardeburg having gone as a member of the first contingent under Capt. Weeks. Her second son Daniel P. McRae is at present a member of the Baden Powell Horse and doing duty at Bloemfontein. Another son Robert left Halifax on board the Manhattan and was present at Hart's River where all in his company were killed or wounded but three. The Mrs. McRae referred to above is the second daughter of the late Thos. Mellish Esq. Union Road Lot 51.
