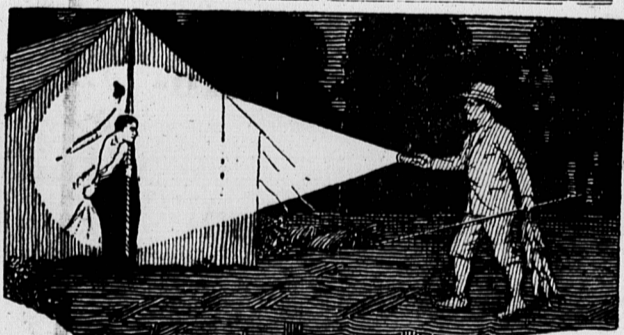

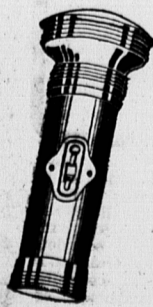

Ideas on Woman

(By Dominion News Service)

LONDON, July 22.-Anthony Ludovici's new book entitled "Woman, A Vindication," which has just been published, is sure to stir a storm of protest.

The woman who takes up this stout and imposing volume, expecting to find yet another spirited defence of her modernity and emancipation, will get the shock of her life.

In his introduction Mr. Ludovici makes it clear that he is "a deep and passionate admirer and lover of woman." But in his opinion she is a Robotess who has got thoroughly out of hand.

Day and night women must be kept in dependence by the males of their families her father protects her in childhood, her husband protects her in youth, and her sons protect her in old age, a woman is never fit for independence.

Mr. Ludovici divides woman into two classes-Positive women, healthy and fully formed, whose idea of life is marriage and motherhood; and Negative woman, whose energy is spent in perverted directions. Owing to the large and increasing number of negative, or sexual, women, Feminism has become the creed of the age, and Western civilization is in grave danger.

This is largely the creation of wealthy spinsters, to whom as a class the author has a bitter dislike. He would put them away under State supervision and deny them money or property, just to learn 'em to be spinsters or super-uous women.

Almost everybody to-day is an unconscious feminist no one seriously doubts that women have exercised a beneficent influence over civilization the absurd idealism which represents woman as the selfish partner in human life is universally accepted three-quarters of our population, including our leading critics and publicists, are even aware that Feminism is their ruling creed.

Woman and the Arts. If this book is revolutionary, it is at any rate logical. Mr. Ludovici believes that woman is ruled entirely by her reproductive instinct, and that when she sins, she does so because Life compels her to reproduce at any cost. So he states emphatically that there is no future for her in art, science, or literature.

Men ought not to dream of placing women on juries, or making them judges of anything except the most trivial and impersonal questions it is hardly a twofold since women have been sitting on juries, a gross miscarriage of justice has occurred.

So, according to the author, ought to be for women, and against the monotonous marriage, and for some system of concubinage, he states that "women get so much more pleasure out of sex than men"; this will not commend itself to the modern woman.
