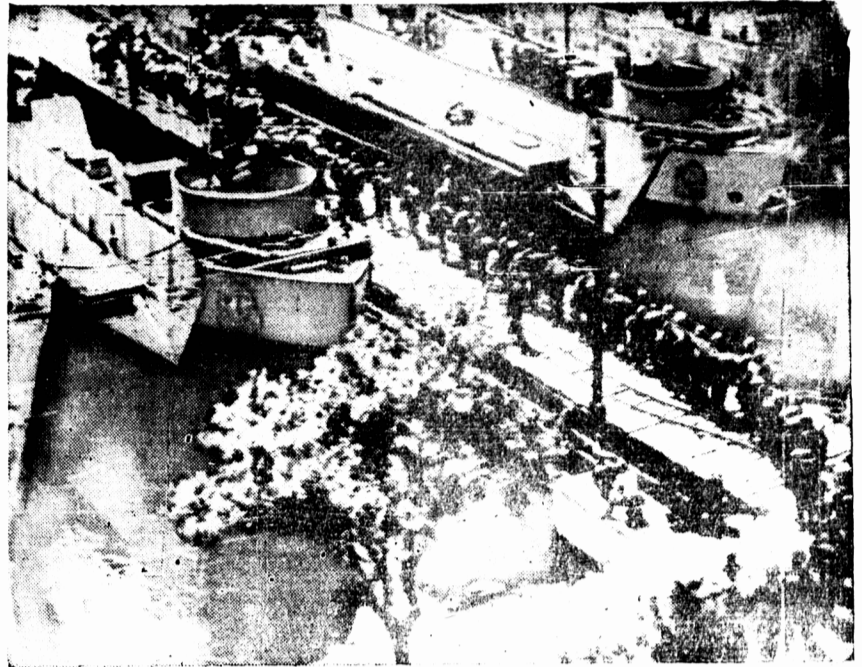

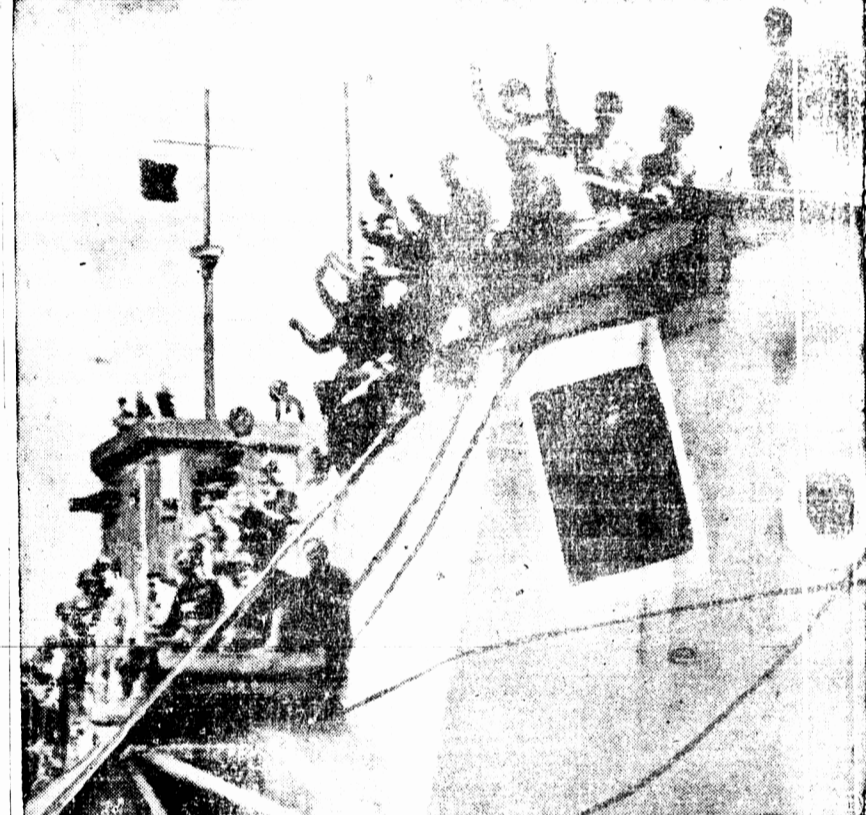

SLAP ON BACK AWAKE MEMORY

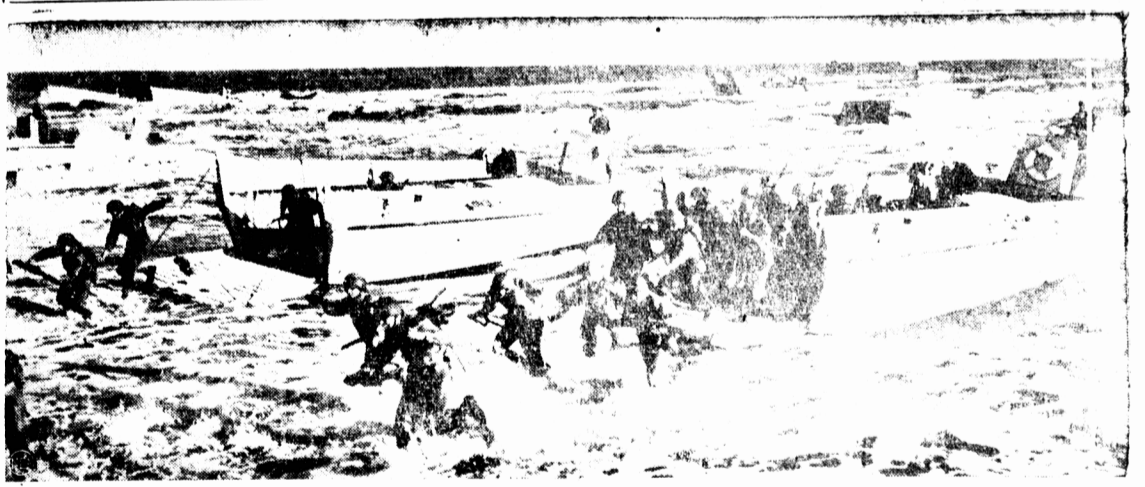

So Long, See You in Sicily

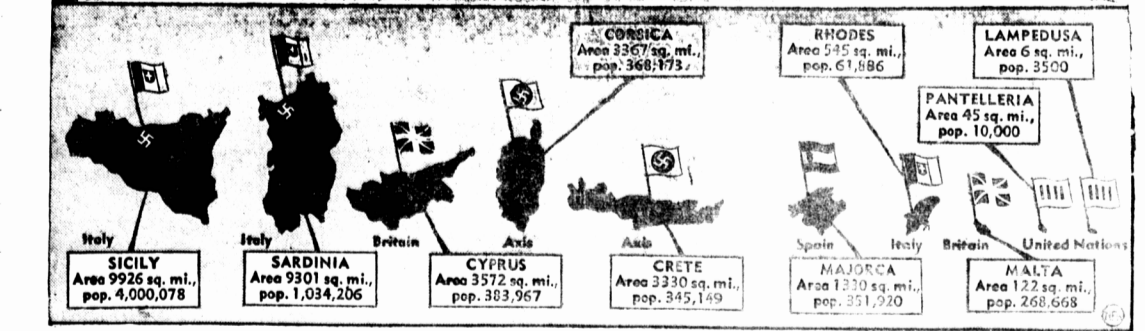


Allied assault troops aboard a sea-going landing barge cheerily wave good-bye as they shove off from a North African port, headed for Sicily.

Ten little islands, sitting in the sea—these are the immediate battle areas of the Mediterranean. Some, like Sicily, Malta and Pantelleria, have taken heavy punishment from bombers of the warring forces. Others, like Sardinia, Crete and Rhodes, in the Dodecanese, seem destined for invasion by Allies. Even Spain's Majorca, in the Balearic group, occupies a precarious position. Map shows lineup of the islands according to size and their current possessors. All would fit in state of Indiana.
