MILITIA CHANGES.

OTTAWA, August, 21— Before sailing for England Colonel Sam Hughes, minister of militia arranged for a general shift among the senior officers of the militia. As already announced, Major General O'Rourke is to retire from the post of inspector general, the date set being December 1st, next.

Colonel R. L. Wadmore, district officer commanding district No. 11, British Columbia and Yukon, will be retired on or about the 30th of August. He has held his post for two years.

Colonel A. Roy, M. V. O., the officer commanding the fourth division at Montreal, goes to Vancouver to succeed Colonel Wadmore.

Colonel Septimus J. A. Dennison, C. M. G., R. C. R. commandant of the R. C. R., Halifax, becomes officer commanding the fourth division at Montreal in place of Colonel Roy.

Lieutenant Colonel J. A. Paves, at present in Montreal, V. A. S. Williams, Q. M. G., succeeds Colonel Dennison, in command of the Royal Canadian regiment.

Colonel J. C. MacDougal, R. T. R., A. A. G., at Montreal, is to come to Ottawa, as assistant to the adjutant general, Colonel Henry Smith.
