TWO YEAR COURTSHIP ENOUGH SAY WOMEN

BOSTON, March 14.—Boston women have started a movement to protect marriageable girls from long courtships, which, they declare, are unjust. They want two years to be the legal limit.

The matter has been brought to a climax by a bill before the Legislature for a tax on bachelors of \$5 a year to be paid to the city or town in which they live, the money being used in aid of worthy spinsters who are believed to have passed the marriageable age.

As Governor Walsh and several bachelors who are leaders in the Legislature have not yet rushed this bill through, this two-year limit for courtships it to be tacked on House Bill No. 510.

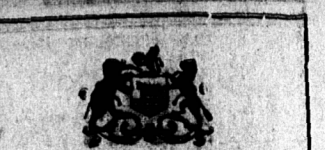
