18-Room Chalet Burned At St. Adele, Que.

(By The Canadian Press) ST. ADELE, Que., Nov. 18.—Damage estimated at \$50,000 were caused today when fire of undetermined origin destroyed the four-story 18-room chalet Morin in this Laurentian Mountain village 80 miles north of Montreal. The fire started about noon when there were several people in the place, the remainder having left to go to church. Citizens of St. Adele offered their help in carting for and sheltering the displaced persons but they were unable to do anything to stop the blaze which the building was razed to the ground. Henri Grignon, Mayor of St. Adele village and chief of the brigade of volunteer firemen, said firefighters were unable to cope with the roaring blaze which is believed to have started in the floor between the furnace room and the kitchen. Leo Martin, proprietor of the resort hotel, said he planned to rebuild immediately providing the necessary materials were available.
