Contract Bridge

USING A SINGLETON

Earlier this week I presented a deal in which the proper defense ignored the apparently dangerous singleton in dummy.

Today and tomorrow I shall show how it's some distributional factor in the dummy — can sometimes be put to better than ordinary use by a wily declarer.

The actual declarer was not so foolish. He saw the losers in the combined hands and set out to do something about them. At the second trick he led the spade four toward dummy's queen!

The beauty of this play lies in its simplicity and complete safety. If West ducks, not giving South credit for the spade ace, the queen holds and South later discards one of dummy's hearts on the spade ace. If West, as is more likely and proper, puts up the spade king, South can discard both of dummy's low hearts on the ace and jack of spades, and ruff two hearts in dummy, losing only a spade and a club.
