Singapore Refugees Aided By Canadian Gifts of Money

Many Settled in War Work Through Lord Mayor's Fund

(From Queen's Fund Representative) LONDON August—Among the refugees from Singapore who have arrived in England is a 70-year-old woman who had spent most of her life out in Malaya. She has gone there with her husband and they had done well out of rubber. When her husband died she placed the plantation in the hands of a manager. She has a steady income from the estate and it seemed that she would be able to live out her years in comfort, with nothing to worry about. Then came the Japanese. She was among those who got cut through Singapore and eventually reached Britain. But formerly well-to-do and apparently secure, she now hasn't a penny. All her possessions—the plantation, her home, everything—were set ablaze by the scorched earth policy. But on her arrival in England she was met at the wharf by a representative of the Lord Mayor's Fund and he at once placed money at her disposal, to augment the few pounds allowed to her by the Government. This is just one of the many stories of the good work done by the Lord Mayor's Fund with Canadian dollars subscribed through the Queen's Fund. CONTINUOUS AID The aid moreover is continuous. These refugees, like the war victims

of Britain itself are cared for until they are able to support themselves. They are assisted to find suitable work—and it has just been announced that 60 per cent of the first batch of refugees from Singapore have been settled in war work of different kinds.
