### AMERICAN EXPORT ON-CANADIAN BANKS.

TORONTO, October 10.—Stuart Strath, general manager of the Traders' Bank of Canada, interviewed regarding the exhaustive report on the Canadian banking system made by Prof. J. F. Johnson, of the New York University School of Commerce, Accounts and Finance, just published under the auspices of the National Monetary Commission of the United States, said:

"Prof. Johnson's report is undoubtedly a tribute to the Canadian banking system. His objections for the most part are general, and appear to have been made without having a precise knowledge of the facts, as interest paid on deposits, and the matter of competition.

"In regard to his claim that the banking capital is too small, I have to point out that in England the capital of the banks is considerably below the ratio maintained by Canadian banks. We do not claim that our system is perfect, as the decimal amendments to the Bank Act clearly indicate."

### BODY OF PHYSICIAN NOT BADLY BURNED.

ST. JOHN, Oct. 11.—The body of Dr. Reynolds, of Lepreau, who was found dead in his house Saturday morning after the structure had been partly destroyed by fire, was brought to the city last night. The services at Lepreau were conducted by Mr. Bowell, of the Plymouth Brethren, at the house of Dr. Reynolds' son. The interment will take place from the Congregational church at 2.30 p. m. today to Fernhill. It was found that the body of deceased was not badly disfigured, the only serious burn being on one of his wrists. Therefore it is believed that he was smothered to death. It appears that it had been his habit to sleep in a large front room. On account of the cold, however, he probably moved into the smaller room, where his body was found. The body was lying with the feet to the door and the head to the bed.

### INDIANS ARE IMPROVING.

OTTAWA, Oct. 12.—The annual report of the Department of Indian Affairs shows that the general condition of the government wards during the last fiscal year has seldom been more uniformly satisfactory. Improvement in vital statistics, morality, education, industrial conditions, agriculture, sanitation and in a higher scale of civilization generally is noted.

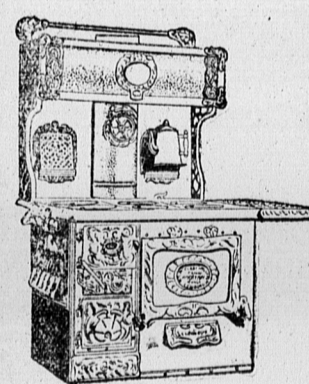

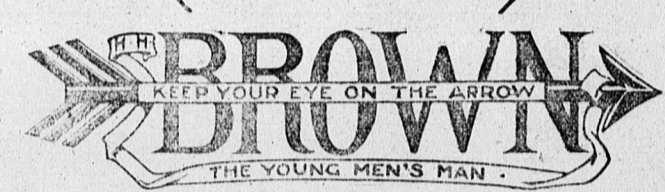

### GRAND PRIZE AUTO RACE

NEW YORK, Oct. 10.—The contest committee of the automobile club of America today acted favorably upon the application of the Savannah automobile club and the municipal authorities of that city, to transfer the grand prize automobile race from Long Island to Savannah.

The contest committee must secure the ratification of the board of governors of the automobile club of America before today's decision can be acted upon. A meeting of that body has been called for tomorrow, and it is a foregone conclusion that the action of the contest committee will be upheld. A tentative date of November 12 has been set for the contest.

### INDIAN WON AT TORONTO.

TORONTO, Oct. 10.—The Ward Marathon, the race which has become famous as having first brought Tom Longboat to notice, was run again on Saturday. The start was made at the exhibition grounds and the runners made two laps of the course before taking to the road. Then along the lake shore they went to Long Branch and back, a distance of 18½ miles.

Some twelve thousand people saw the finish. The winner was James George, an Indian from Beaverton, who covered the course in 1:55, 45 3-5. Levi Jamieson, a Brantford Indian, who won the Foster Marathon, was second. Dan Sheridan, of Vermont A. C., third and Milton Fenn, of the British United, fourth.
