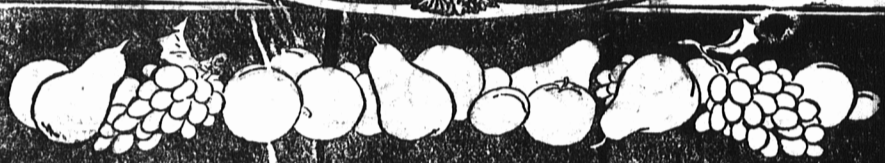

TO RECONCILE MANKIND TO GOD

methods of salvation. It starts us when we think we are under no such obligation to repent as we are not to steal or commit murder. Yet the fact remains that all men everywhere are commanded to turn away from evil, give up their own petty schemes of bettering men, and be reconciled to God's plan of saving humanity by the destruction of evil. You say, why need you talk thus to us, are we not Christians? Yes, no doubt you are in some respects but there is yet a good deal about the most of us that is decidedly not Christian. Listen till I read you some of Christ's plans to which He urges us by His ambassadors to be reconciled. "Blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." We do not always lay our plans for life so that this poverty of spirit will be a necessary outcome, and thus far we are not reconciled to God's purposes. And again, "Blessed are the meek for they shall inherit the earth." Our purposes in life as a rule are not marked by their tendencies to produce weakness. We have a sort of suspicion that a meek man is not very much good, that he can scarcely fight his way in this busy commercial age of ours. We assume that to be meek would be to be trampled upon shovelled to the wall by the more aggressive and self-assertive business men. Here we set up our own wisdom against the wisdom that has created worlds. Again: "Blessed are ye when men shall revile you and persecute you and say all manner of evil against you falsely for My sake." This does not come into our plan of life. We drift out plans of life so that we can be Christians so far as it is popular and conforms to public taste. We go to church regularly because that is considered good form. We put our names down as Christians when the census is taken, and support the enterprises of the church because other people do, but when surrounded by a godless crowd or mingling with an irreligious company, we are not apt to manifest many virtues of the Christian life as laid down by Jesus in the Sermon on the Mount, lest we might be laughed at or someone might think us queer. I myself have known persons who thought it right when alone to commit themselves to God by prayer before they retired for the night, but in company with the godless at an hotel would neglect the duty rather than be laughed at by their companions. Have you ever known men who were temperate in principle, who would take a glass of something to drink because they were surrounded by a brilliant Godless company? This is not a plan of living. God's plan is to be true to God and to our manhood, absolutely regardless of consequences; and it is God's plan of life that the apostle is beseeching the Corinthians to be reconciled.

But again: If we have Christ's plan of saving and civilizing the world set forth in His life and teachings, it differs from our plans in another very important particular. Christ's methods seem to demand that reform must begin within, our plans generally begin from without. Christ's method of saving and civilizing the world and consequently the destruction of evils by making good men and good women, not as communities or nations but as individuals. This I think is the meaning of what He said to the Jewish Rabbi when they met in Jerusalem: "Except a man be born of water and the spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." Mind He did not say a corporation, or a province or a nation, but a man, anyone. This was the method followed by the Apostles, this is the method that has been indorsed by the church for two thousand years. Differ as much as we may about how this is accomplished, the fact remains that all Christians hold to this truth. When this illumination, or quickening, or salvation, or what you please to call it, comes into an individual life and that life is reconciled to God's purposes in this world, God says that individual as the salt to preserve the circle in which He moves. "Ye are the salt of the earth" said Jesus; then follow the sad words: "But if the salt have lost its savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is henceforth good for nothing but to be cast out and trodden under foot of men." So you see a Christian who has not sufficient Christianity or salt enough in him to preserve the circle in which he moves is a good to that circle according to Christ's plan. Ah, more than that, he is no good to God. "Ye are the Light of the world," the Christian's life is to make clear to those with whom he associates, the eternal difference that exists between right and wrong, between the good and the bad, the true and the untrue. Because this is true, a good man, that is a Christian man, is the greatest asset of the nation and the more of them a nation possesses the wealthier the nation is and the less power evil has over it. I am thoroughly convinced that if ever human relations are to be perfectly adjusted, they will be done according to Christ's method, and the sooner the world learns this the better. This then is the preacher's business, it is the business of every Christian to beseech men and women to Christ's standard to be reconciled to God.
