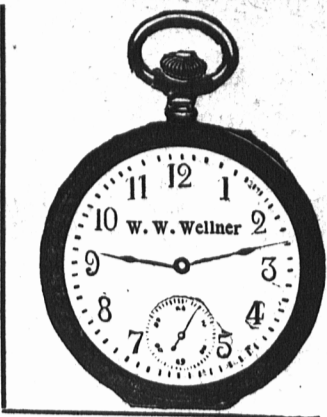

THE EXHIBITION FORMALLY OPENED

By Lieut. Governor McIntyre Yesterday Afternoon.

A Large Attendance for the Opening Day—Excellent Weather for the Opening.

The P. E. L. Agricultural Exhibition was formally opened yesterday afternoon. The weather was beautiful and gave assurance of a week of fine weather. There was a large attendance for the first day. The opening took place on the steps of the main entrance instead of inside the building as on previous years.

Shortly before three o'clock the proceedings opened by the National Anthem rendered by Worth's Band.

The President of the Association then spoke as follows—

Ladies and gentlemen: As President of the Exhibition Association I have much pleasure just now in calling upon His Honor the Lieutenant Governor to formally open this Exhibition. As you know in former years we have always opened our Exhibition inside the building; and as we find it very difficult sometimes to hear a speaker in the open air I will ask you simply to gather around while His Honor is formally opening this Exhibition.

Lieut. Governor McIntyre, in formally opening the exhibition said: Ladies and Gentlemen—I have been asked by the Directors of the Association to open the Exhibition to-day, and I have very much pleasure indeed in doing so. Of course, I have not anything very remarkable to say as occasions of this kind are very much the same year after year; and after the opening remarks by your President, I have no desire to prolong the ceremonies.

On occasions of this kind, of course we have to refer to the weather to-day, and although I am no weather prophet, I feel that we are going to have fine weather during the next few days. This is one of the main features connected with any exhibition, and which contributes largely to its success. I now declare the Exhibition open.

Premier Peters was agreeably surprised and even astonished at the wonderful display especially in fruit. When he went to England everything looked as if it was to be excellent crops. When he returned to us looked bad but notwithstanding this we had an exhibition on which we may be proud.

Mayor Kelly was glad to see such an audience present. The directors must feel gratified at the large number of entries. Exhibitions are educative as well as a source of pleasure to those who attend. He hoped the visitors would carry away good impressions of Charlottetown and return shortly after.

F. W. Hodgson, Dominion Live Stock Commissioner, introduced as one of P. E. Island's best friends, thanked the president for his kind words. He complimented the directors on the fine buildings and grounds which are indeed a monument to the present Directors and those who have gone before. Nova Scotia and New Brunswick have just closed excellent exhibitions but not in these or in Ontario or Quebec had he seen a better or better conducted exhibition than the present one.

This completed the ceremony of the day.

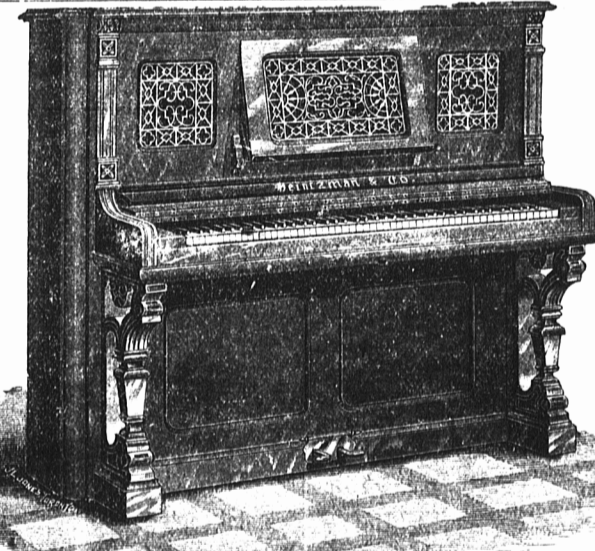

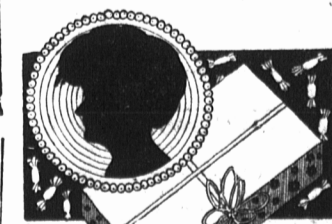
