Double-flanking movement Threatens to exterminate troops Stalled at Stalingrad.

(By Henry C. Cassidy, Associated Press Staff Writer) MOSCOW, Nov. 24 (Tuesday) (AP)—Russian troops in their great new winter offensive have smashed across the Don River to a point approximately 100 miles northwest of Stalingrad in a great double-flanking movement that has cost the Germans 50,000 casualties and threatens to exterminate thousands of other Nazi soldiers stalled near the Volga River to the east, it was announced today.

12-MILE ADVANCE

A special communique—the second in two days—said the town of Chernyshevskaya, well inside the Don River loop, had been taken in a 12-mile continuing advance.

COST TO GERMANS

To date the Russians said their four- or five-day offensive had cost the Germans this toll: 26,000 dead, including 12,000 in Monday's operations alone.
