"But, my dear, when he learns that you don't I'm afraid he'll go to pieces."

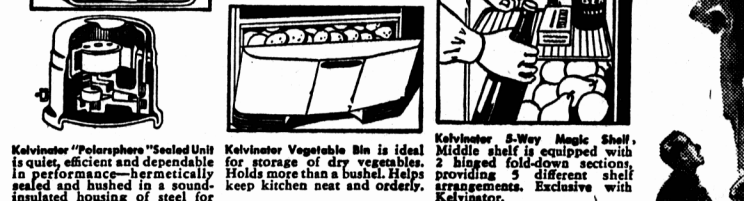
"By that time his work will absorb him completely. Then he will forget all about me. I am just a catalytic agent."
